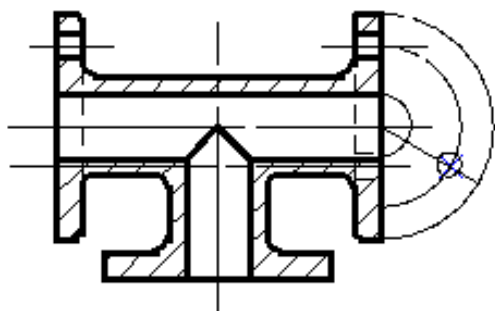

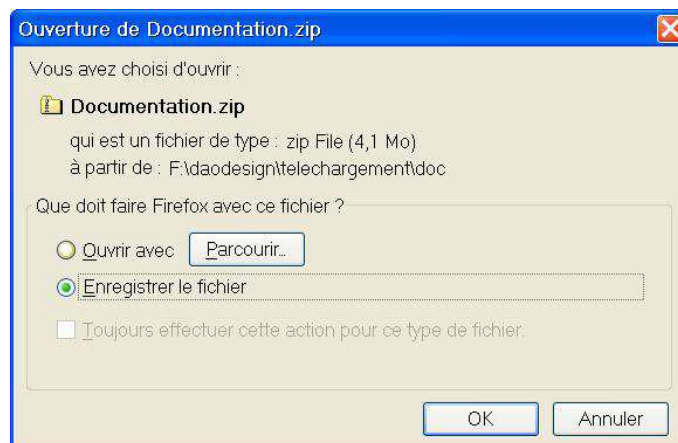
#### 2.1.1 Documentation

- Click Documentation in ZIP format

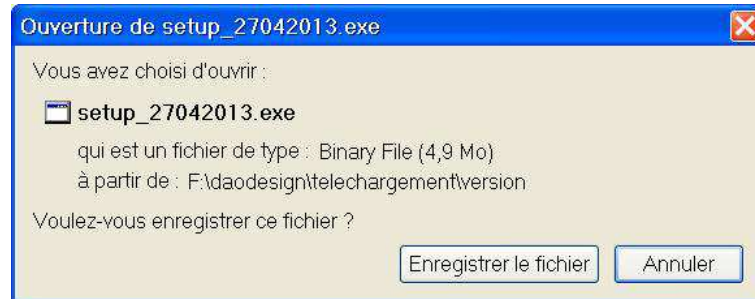
The download box opens and offers to download the documentation.

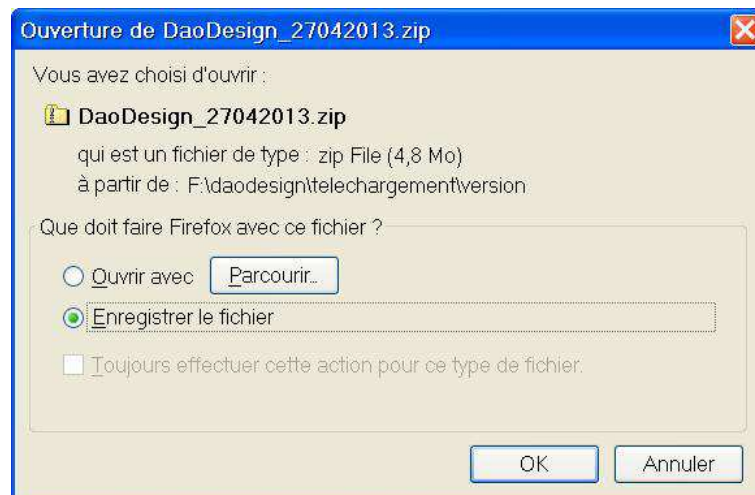
### 2.1.2.1 Windows

### 2.1.2.2 Windows Mac and Linux

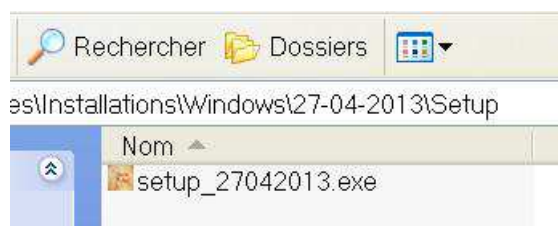
To download the generic installation, valid for Windows and Mac or Linux, simply click on the link **daodesign.zip**. This opens the download box.

1. run setup.exe

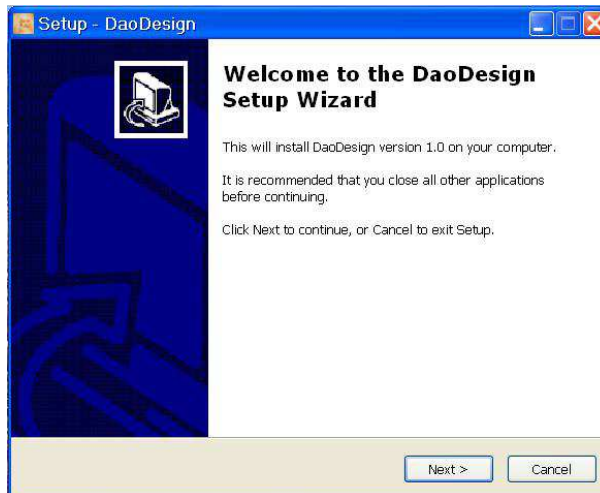


2. Launch the installation wizard

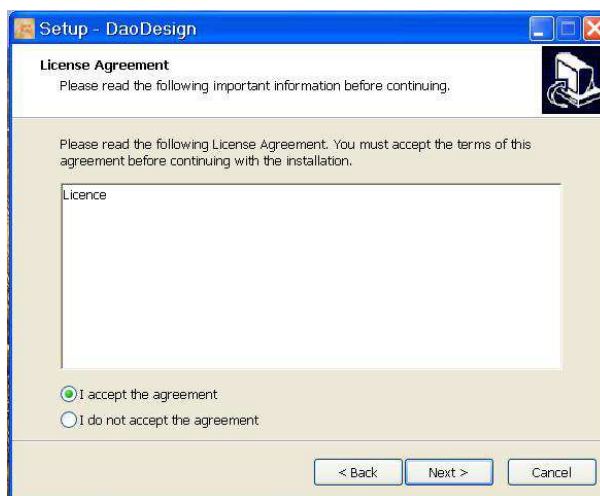




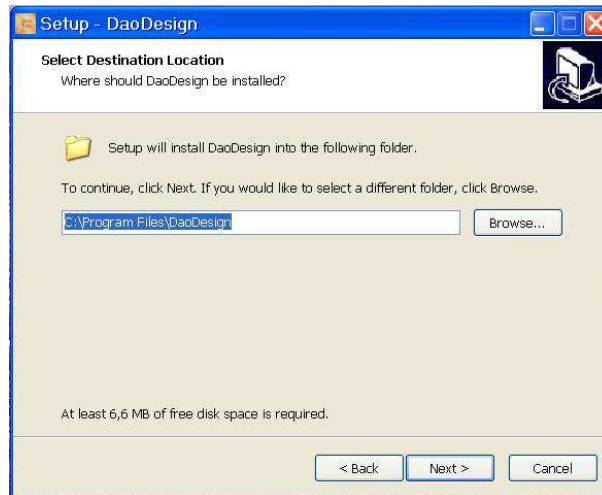
3. Choice of language, then press OK



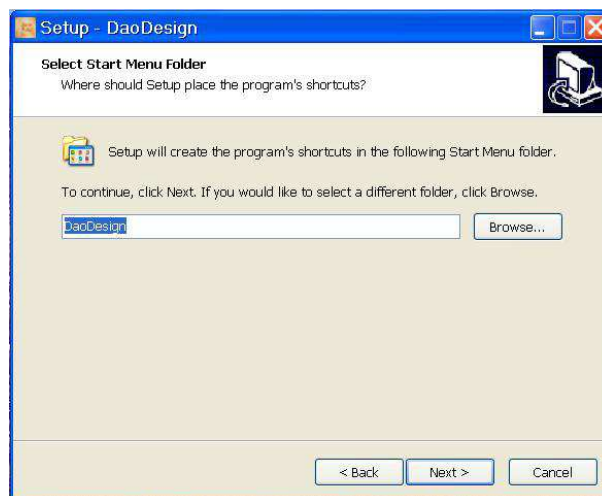
4. Click Next



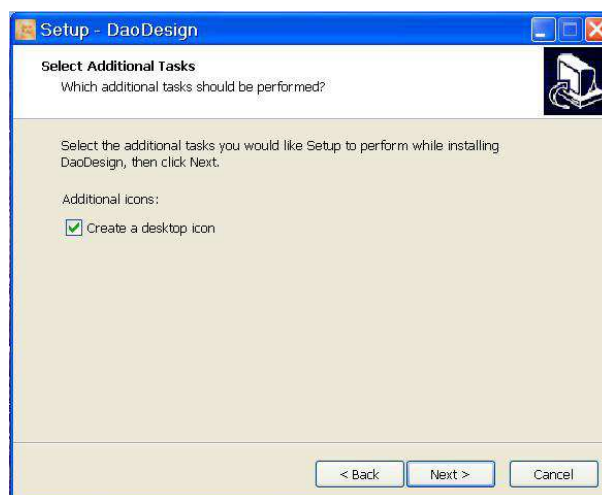
5. Select "I understand and accept the terms of the license agreement" and then press Next



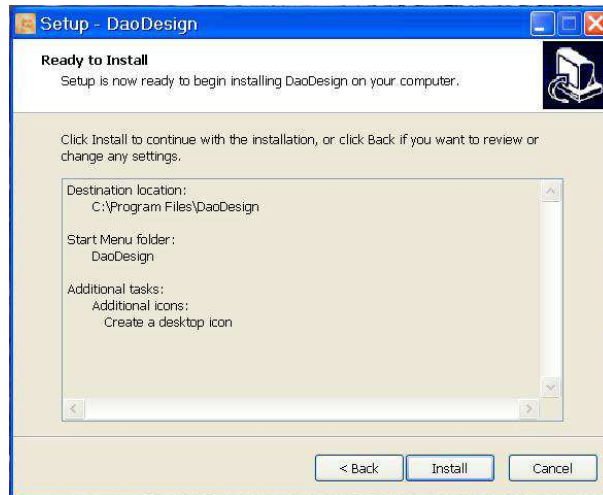
6. Change the installation directory if necessary, then press Next

## 2.3 How to run the software?

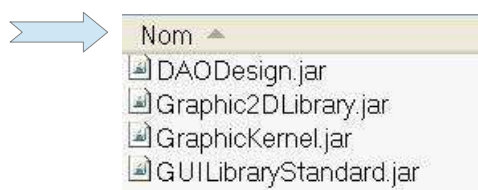
### 2.3.1 Windows with setup.exe

To launch the software, simply double click the icon on the desktop. This icon has been added by the installer.



### 2.3.2 Windows Mac or Linux with generic installation

Double click on the file **daodesign.jar** found in the **exe** directory



## 2.4 How to configure the software?

### 2.4.1 Presentation

When you first launch the application, a wizard guides you to the setup screen. This setting allows the software to meet the real dimensions of page size. It also allows the software to better adapt to different types of screens and screen size, it can go from 17 inches 4/3 to 27 inches 16/9 and more.

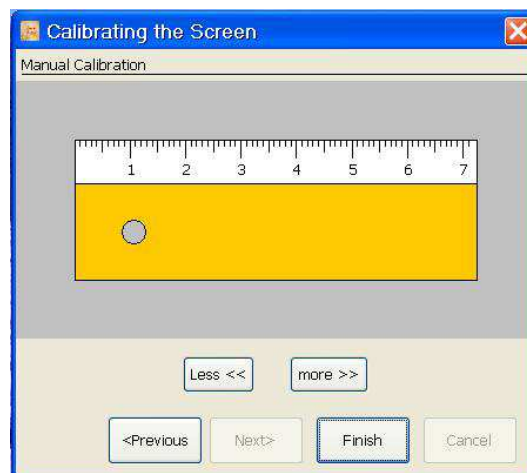
### 2.4.2 The setup wizard screen

#### 2.4.2.1 Choice of parameters



There are two ways to make the setting. Or use the manual setting, or use the setup screen type. The manual setting is certainly easier for people who do not know the parameters of their computer screen, but it is also the most time consuming method.

#### 2.4.2.2 Manual Configuration



This is to match the dimensions of the virtual ruler with the dimensions of a true ruler.

For this it is necessary to modify the virtual set using the buttons more or less. Once done, click Finish.

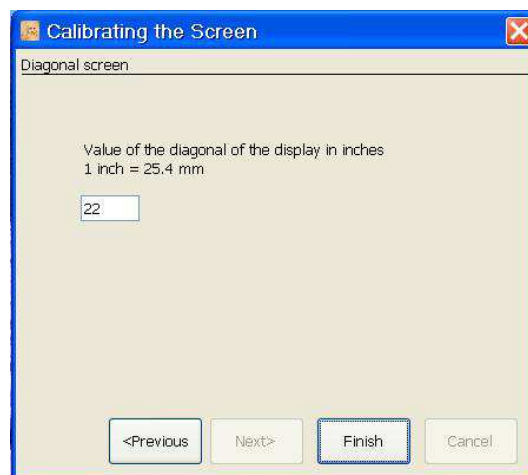
### 2.4.2.3 Configuration screen type

#### 2.4.2.3.1 Selection screen type



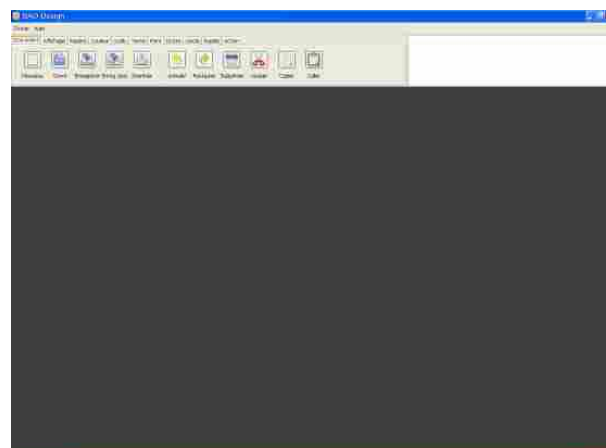
There are four screen sizes available, those are the standard formats. Choose the size of your screen, then click Next.

Enter the size of the diagonal of the display in inches, then click Finish.

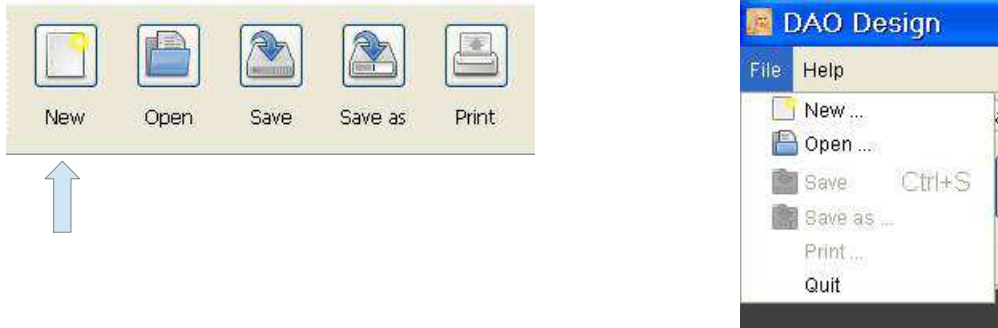

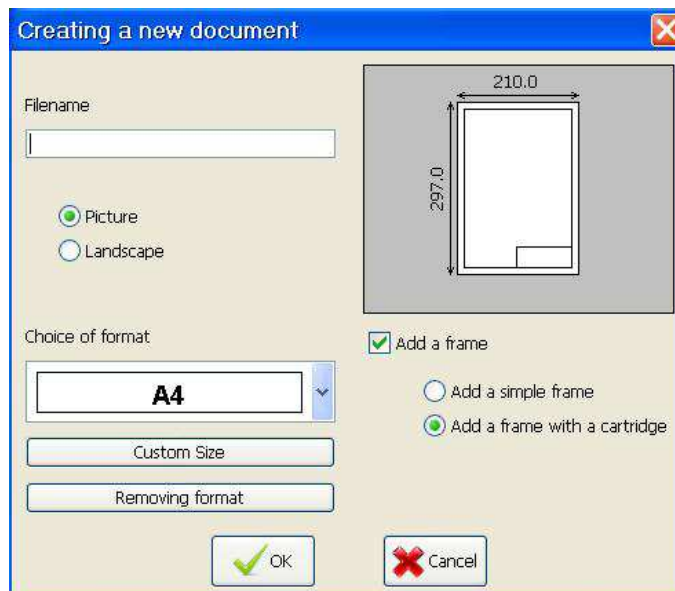
## 3 Document Management

### 3.1 How to create a new document?

There are two ways to create a new document, or use the command **New** of **Document** tool bar, or use the **File / New** menu.

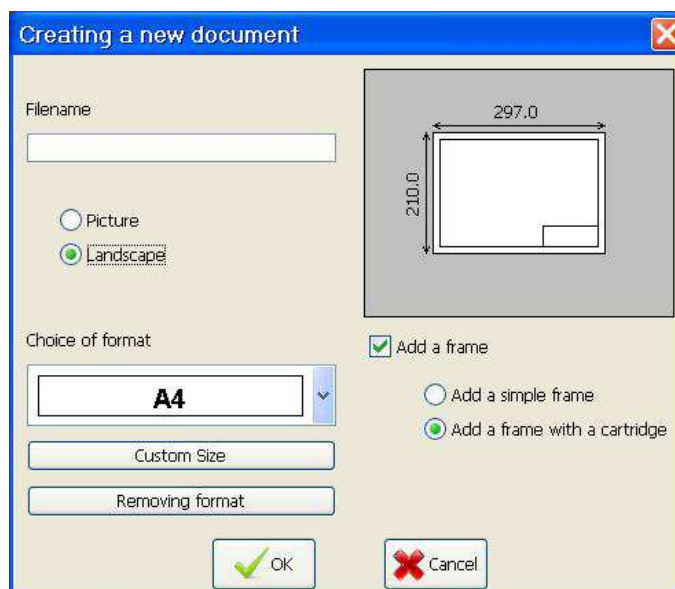


This command will open a dialog box to enter the parameters and configure the new document.



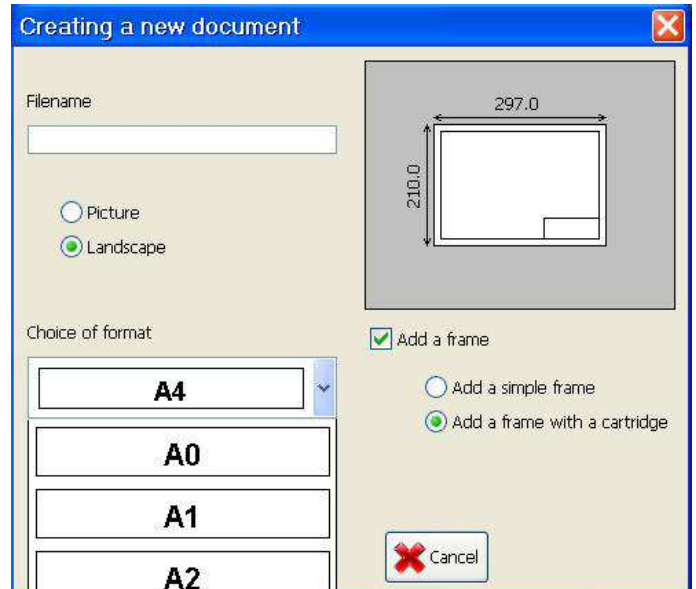
The **File Name** field: This field is required. It is the name of the document.

The buttons **Picture** and **Landscape**: This field has the default value **Picture**.



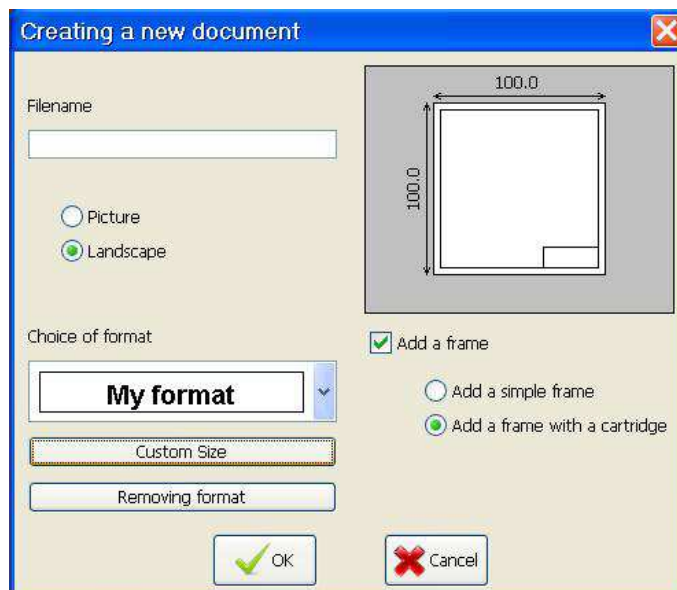
**Choice format** field: This field allows you to choose among several defaults values. These defaults value are A4, A3, A2, A1 and A0. The default value pre-selected is A4.

It is possible to create your own custom format. For this you must use the Custom Size button. This button opens a dialog box for entering the parameters of this new format.



- The field **Name format**: This field is required. It lets you enter the name of the new page size.
- The field **Width of the document**: This field can not be zero. It sets the width of the page.
- The field **Height of the document**: This field can not be zero. It sets the height of the page.

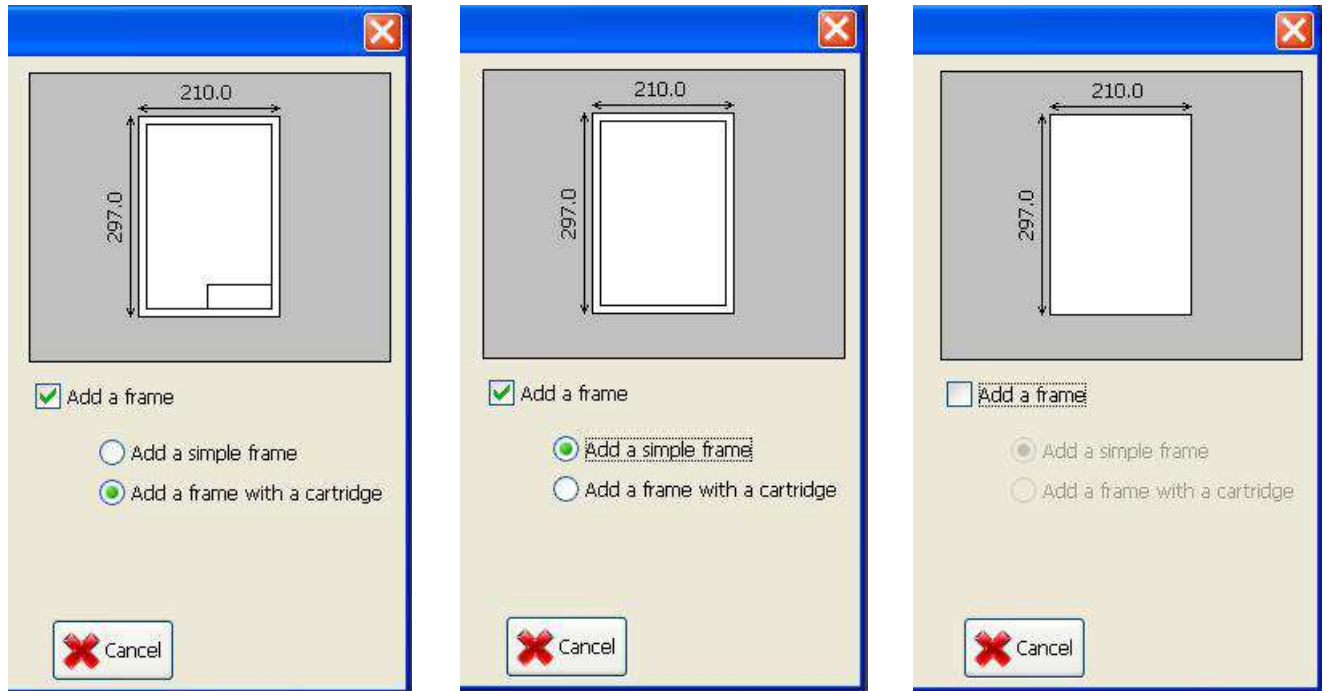
You can later delete a custom format. To do this, use the **Delete format** button. Using this button will delete the selected custom size in the selection box located above. The default formats are not deletable.



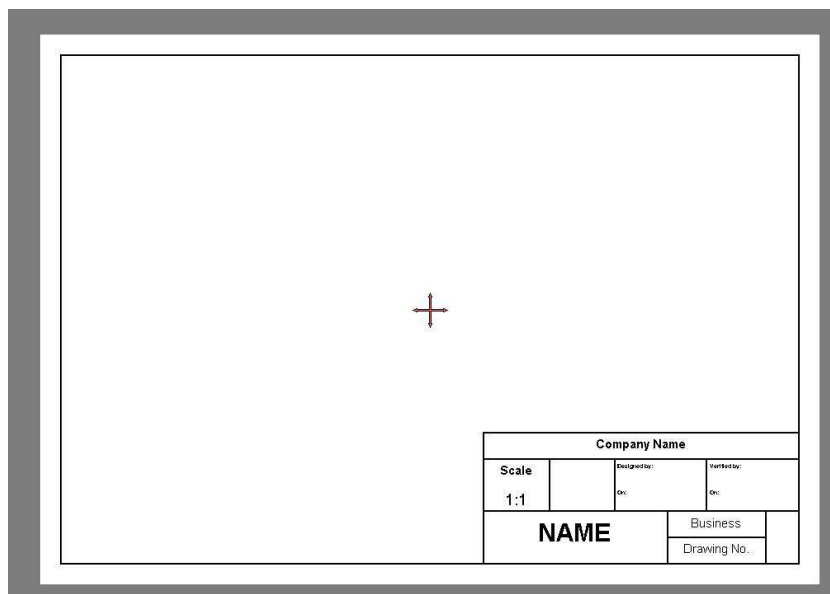
It is possible to add a document frame, either a single or with a cartridge. The default configuration is a frame with a cartridge.



### 3 Document Management - 3.1 How to create a new document?

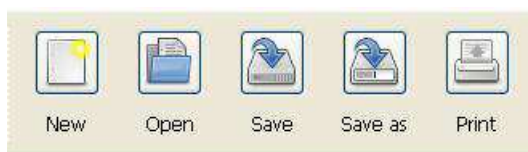


Opening a new document gives access to a blank page representing the workspace. It is in this space that you can draw.



### 3.2 How to open a document?

There are two ways to open a document, or use the command **Open** of the **Document** tool bar, or use the **File / Open** menu.



This command will open a dialog box for entering the name of the document to open, and its type.

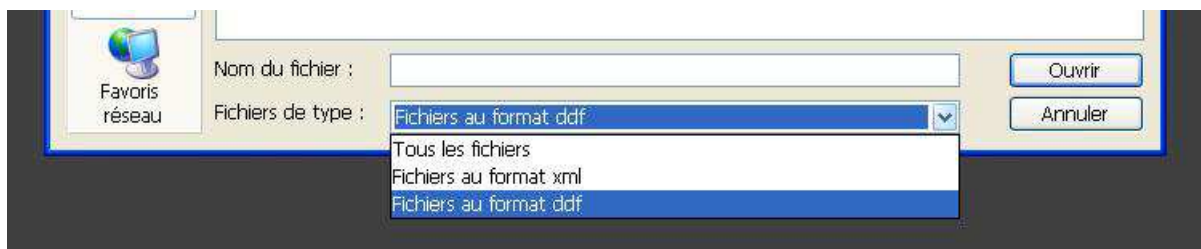
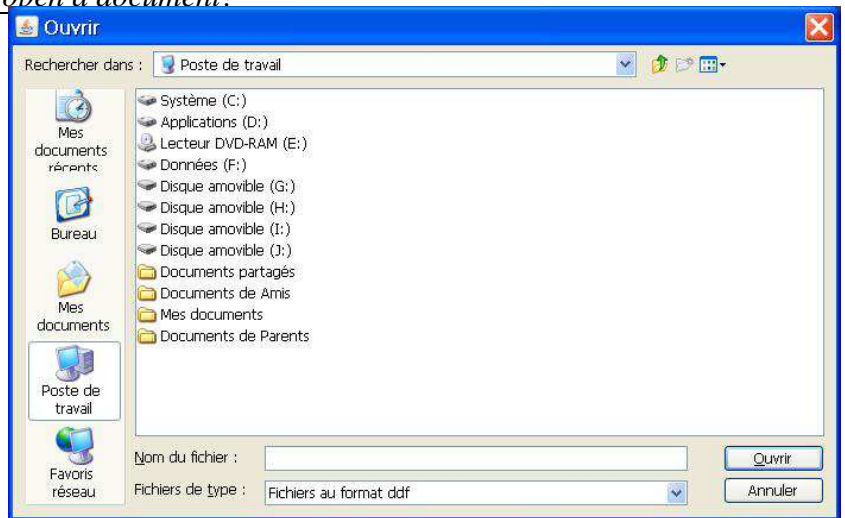


### 3 Document Management - 3.2 How to open a document?

This dialog box is for the Windows operating system.

It allows you to navigate through the file system directory and enter the file to be opened depending on its type.

There are two possible types of files for the software. A first **ddf** format recommended because less bulky space on the hard disk or the second **xml** format.

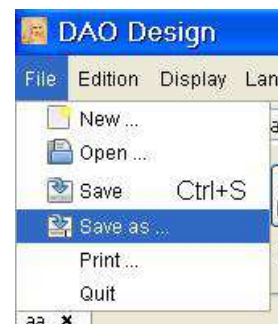
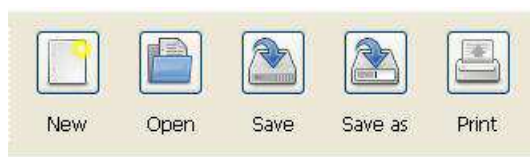


After selecting the file to open, press the open button to open the document. The document appears in the state it was recorded.

### 3.3 How do I save a document?

#### 3.3.1 The Save As command

There are two ways to save a document, or use the command **Save as** of the **Document** tool bar, or use the **File / Save as** menu.



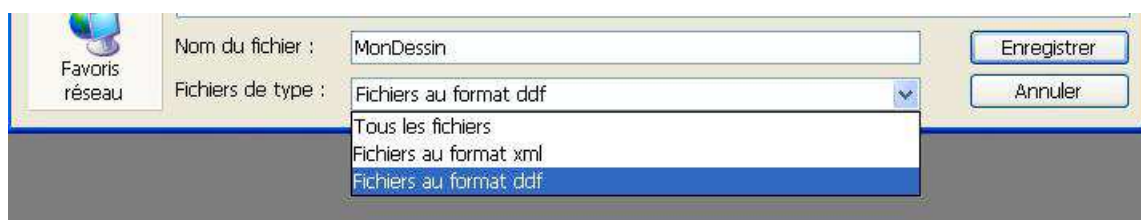
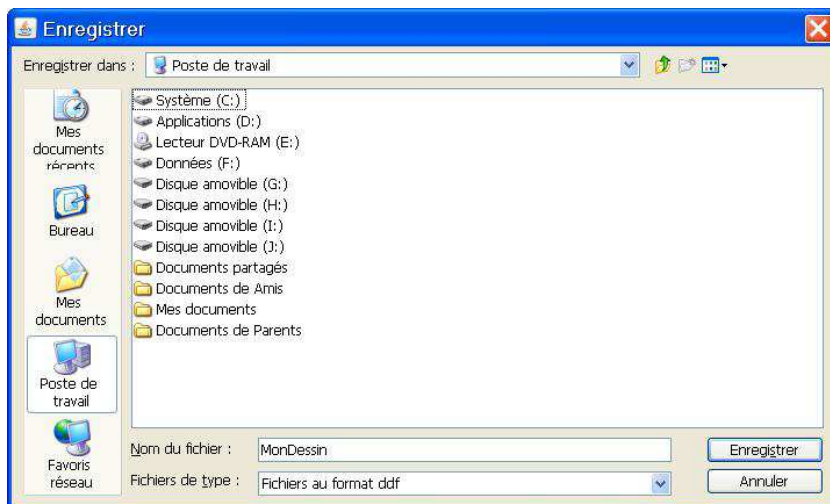
This command will open a dialog box for entering the name of the document to be saved and its type.

This dialog box is for the Windows operating system.

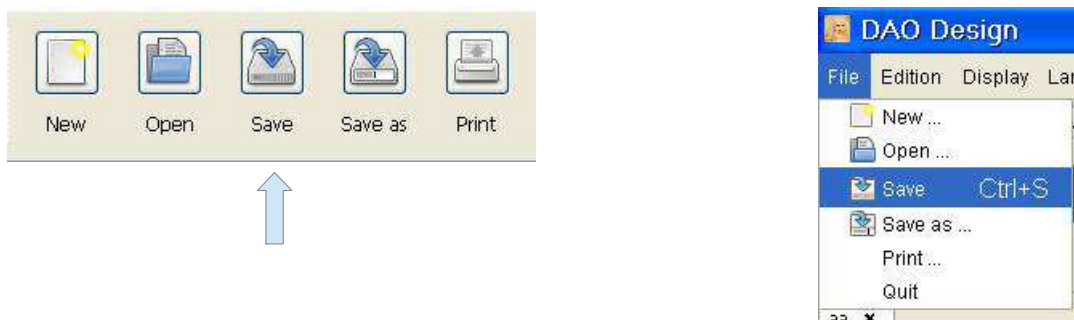
It allows you to navigate through the file system directory and enter the file to be saved depending on its type.

There are two possible types of files for the software. A first **ddf** format recommended because less bulky space on the hard drive or second **xml** format.



#### 3.3.2 The Save command

There are two ways to save a document, or use the command **Save** of the **Document** tool bar, or use the **File / Save** menu.

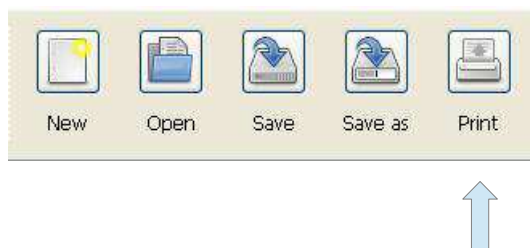


It presents two cases :

- You set the file type in the name when you create the new document. It is. Xml or. Ddf, and in this case the software directly saves the document in the current directory. In this case the current directory is the directory to install the software.
- You have not set type and in this case the software opens a Save As dialog. This dialog box lets you choose the type of file you want to save and the directory on the hard disk.

### 3.4 How to print a document?

To print a document, use the **Print** command from the **Document** toolbar.

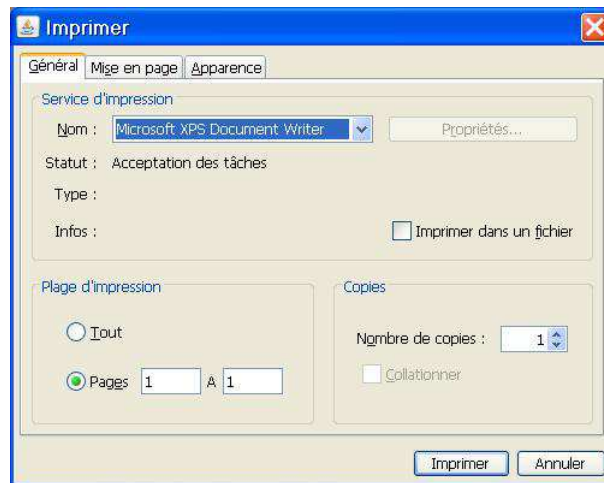


### 3 Document Management - 3.4 How to print a document?

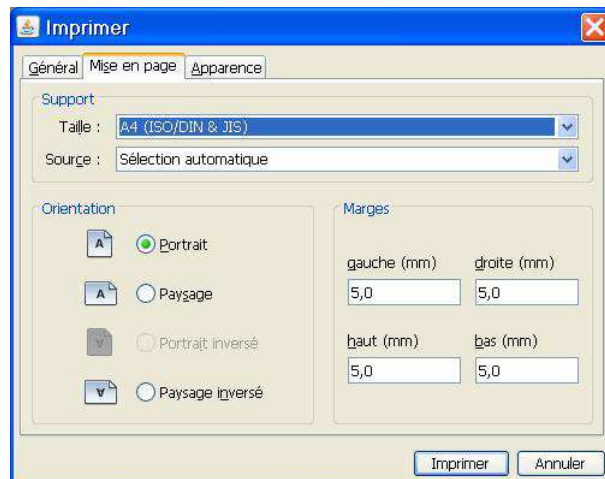
This command will open a dialog box to define the various print settings. This dialog box is the same on all operating systems.

It consists of three tabs:

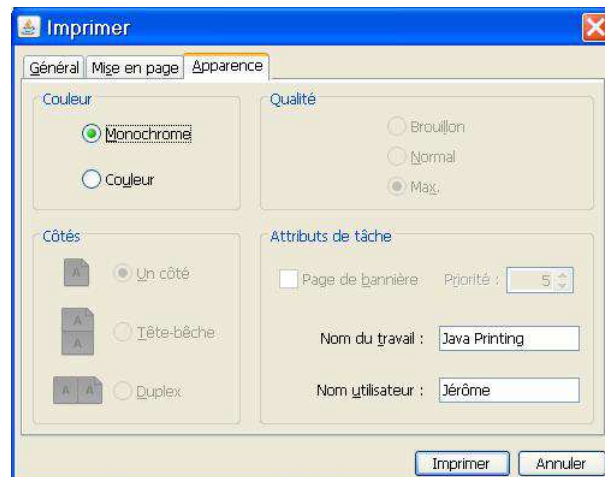
- The **General** tab



- The **Layout** tab



- The **Appearance** tab

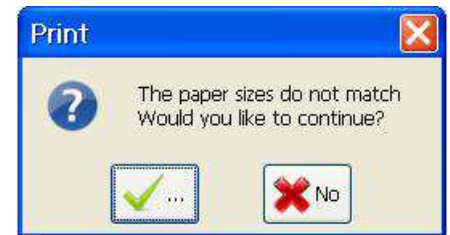


The dialog is normally set correctly by default. The only information to learn from you are:

- Field **Name**: This is the printer you want to print.
- Field **Size**: This is the paper format. The default size is A4. You will need to change in case you want to print on a different format.

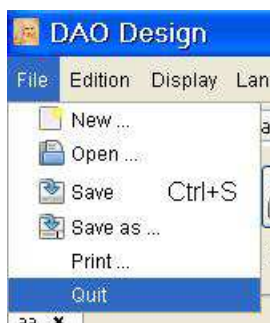
In case the size of the document does not match the paper size of the printer, a dialog box appears to warn you.

If you choose to continue, the software will adapt to better scale and position of the document on the page.



### 3.5 How to exit the program?

To do this, simply go to the File menu and select the Exit command.

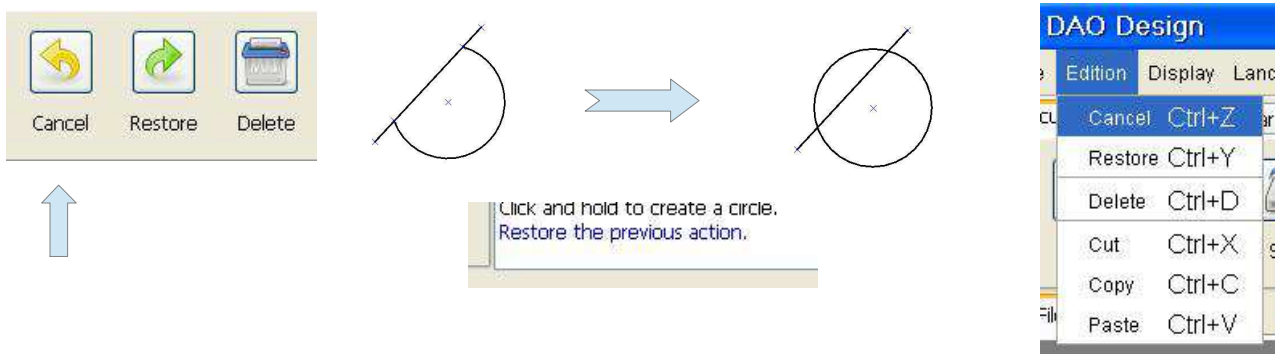


If an open document needs to be saved, a dialog box will ask for confirmation.

### 3.6 How to cancel or restore action?

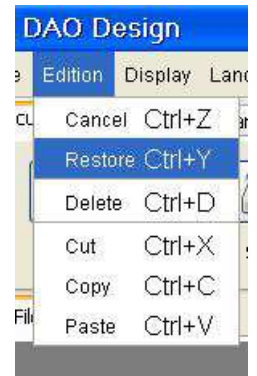
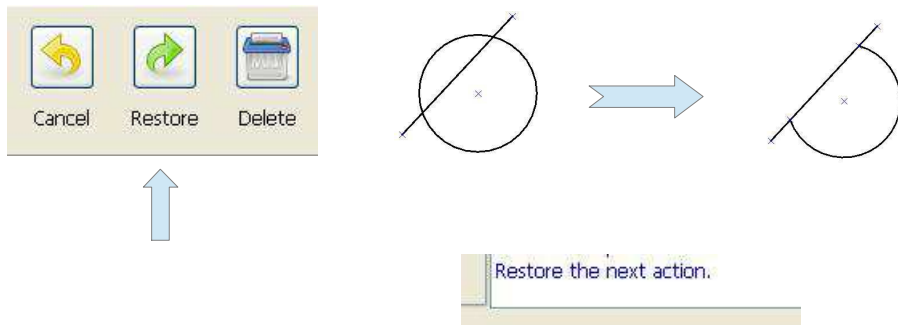
#### 3.6.1 How to cancel an action?

There are two ways to cancel an action in a document, or use the command **Cancel** of the **Edit** tool bar, or use the **Edit / Cancel** menu.

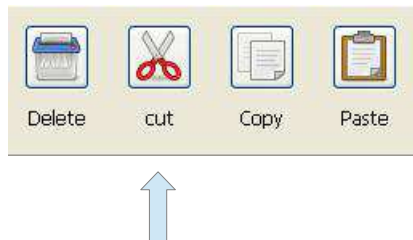


#### 3.6.2 How to restore an action?

### 3.7 How to cut a selection?

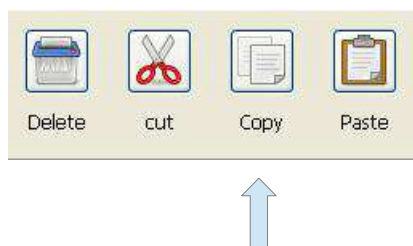


Must initially select the object or group of objects to be cut.

### 3.8 How to Copy a selection?

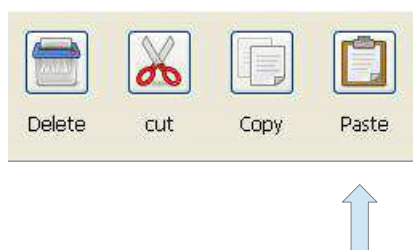


Must initially select the object or group of objects to copy.

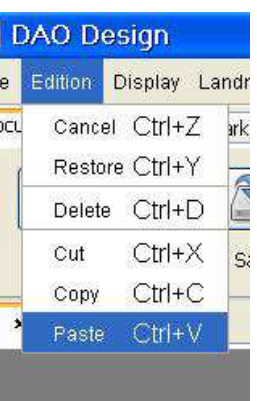
There are two ways to copy a selection in a document, or use the command **Copy** of the **Edit** tool bar, or use the **Edit / Copy** menu.

## 4 The display management

### 4.1 How to zoom in the document?

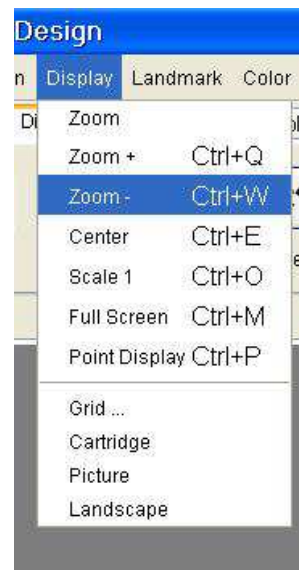
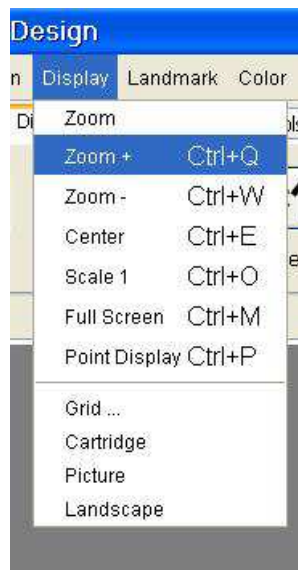


It is possible to zoom into the document using the Zoom toolbar. This toolbar is located in the Display tab.

In the center is the display of the zoom. The 100 means 100% which corresponds to a scale of 1 to display the document.

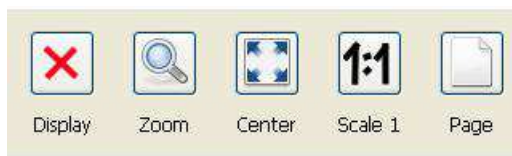
The left button allows you to zoom out, and thus view the document smaller, the right button zooms and thus view the document bigger.

You can use the menu View / Zoom+ and the menu View / Zoom -.

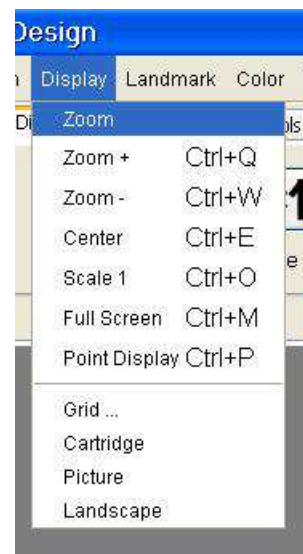
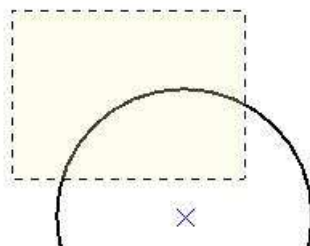


It is also possible to zoom using the zoom control.

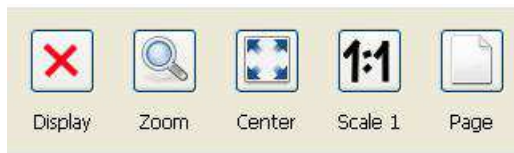
There are two ways to zoom in the document, or use the command **Zoom** of the **Display** tool bar, or use the **View / Zoom** menu.



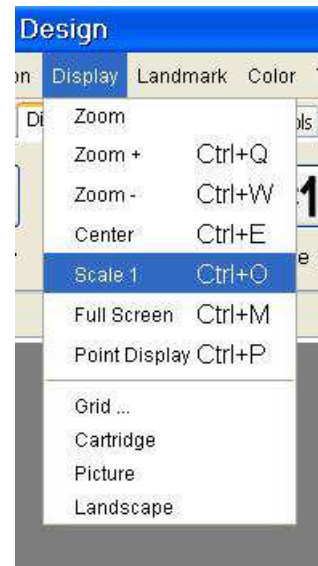
The zoom control allows you to zoom in the document using the mouse.



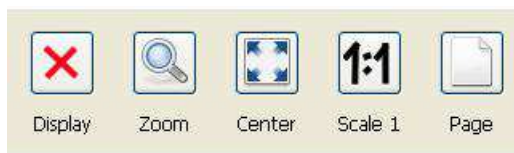
## 4.2 How to scale 1 a document?



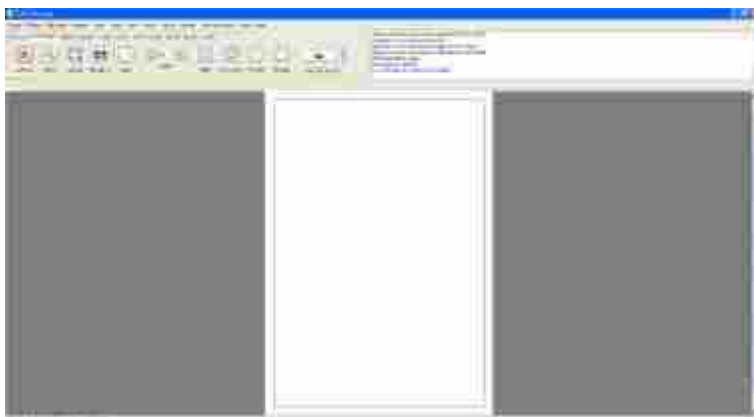
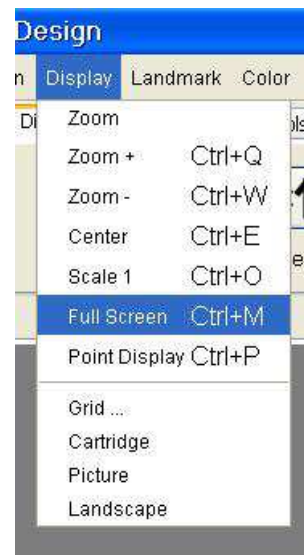
There are two ways to put a document on the scale one, or use the command **Scale 1** of the **Display** tool bar, or use the **Display / Scale 1** menu.



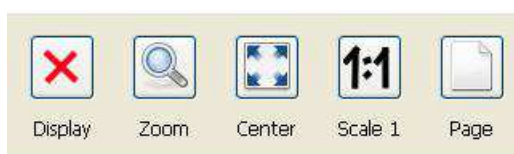
## 4.3 How to full page?



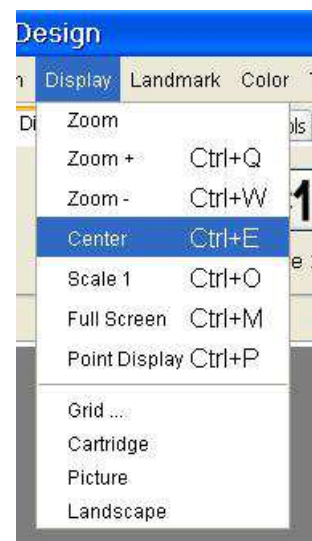
There are two ways to put a document in full screen, or use the command **Page** of the **Display** tool bar, or use the **Display / Full Screen** menu.

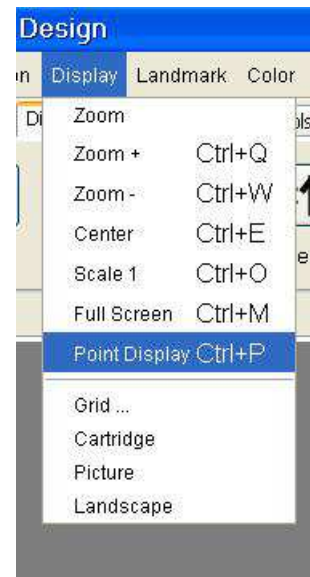
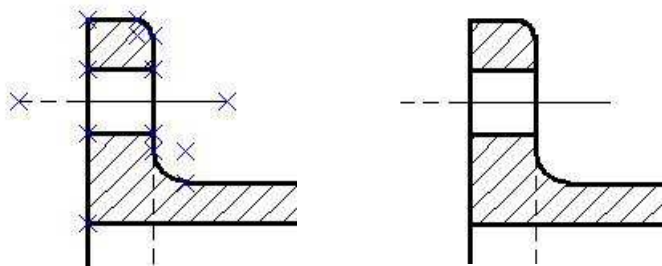
There are two ways to center a document or use the command **Center** of the **Display** tool bar, or use the **Display / Center** menu.



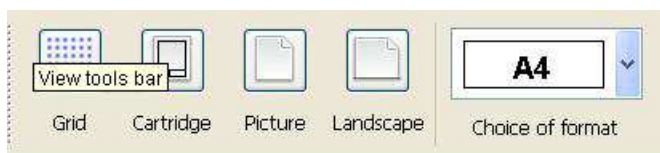
## 4.5 How do I cancel or restore the display points?

## 4.6 How to turn on the grid?

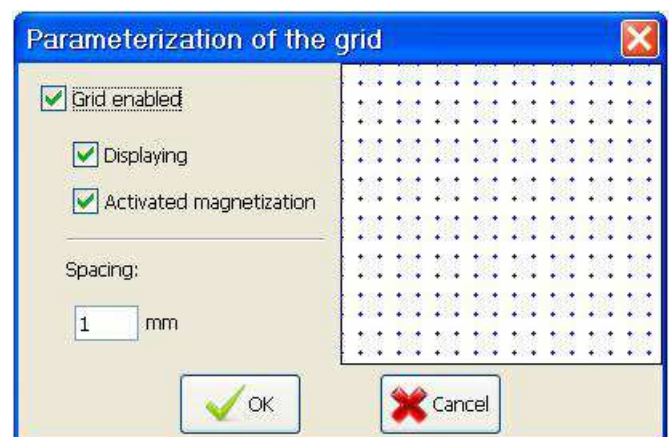
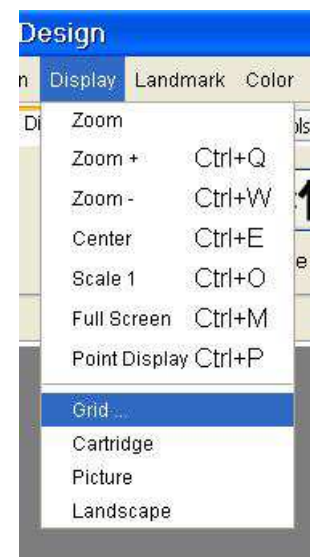


There are two ways to access the configuration of the grid of a document, or use the command **Grid** of the **Display** toolbar, or use the **Display / Grid** menu.

This command will open a dialog box to enter and configure the grid.

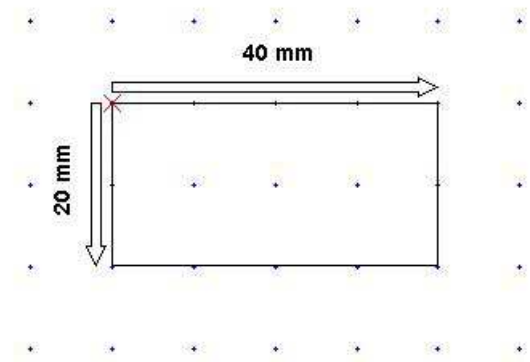
The dialog box is divided into two parts, one to the left to enter and configure the grid, and some on the right to see the grid.

- The **Grid enabled** field: This field is used to enable or disable the grid and take into account whether or not the set of parameters defined for it.
- The field **Viewing**: This field enables the visualization of the grid through blue dots.
- The **Activated magnetization** field: This field allows drawing elements from sticking to the grill.
- The field **Spacing**: This field corresponds to the pitch of the grid.

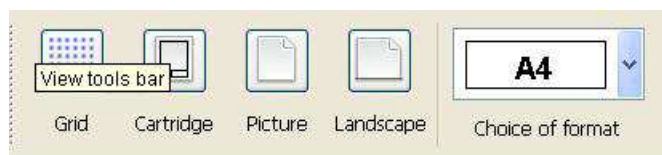




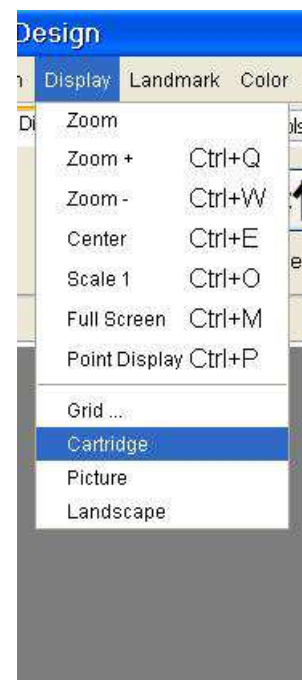
Here is an example of drawing a rectangle on a magnetic grid of 10 mm.



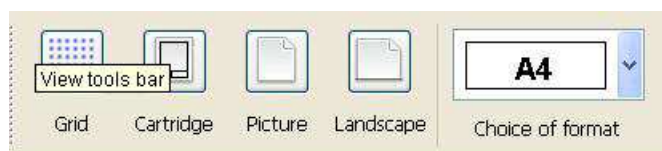
#### 4.7 How to display the cartridge?



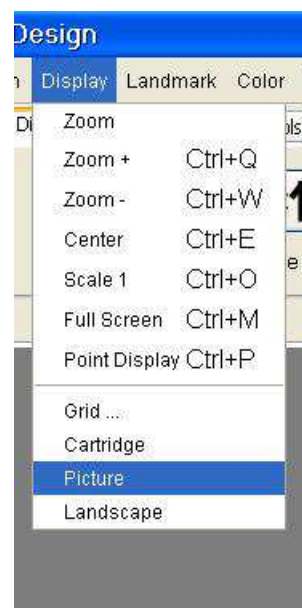

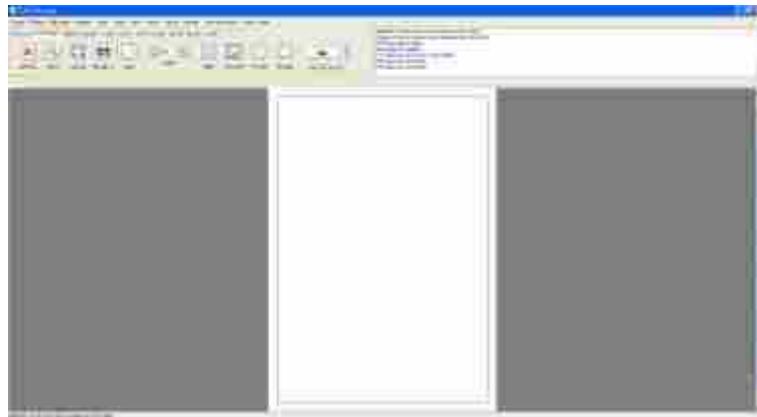


#### 4.8 How to display the document in portrait?

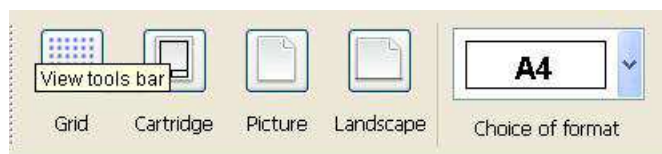


There are two ways to display the document in picture or use the command **Picture** of the **Display** toolbar, or use the **Display / Picture** menu.

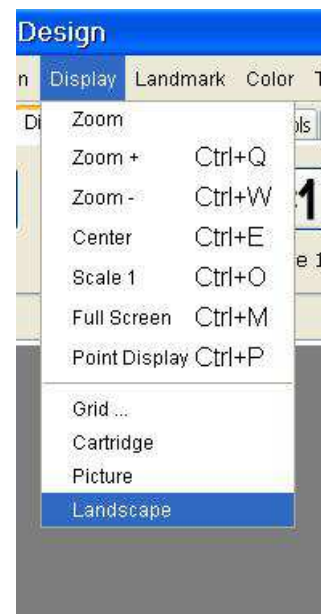
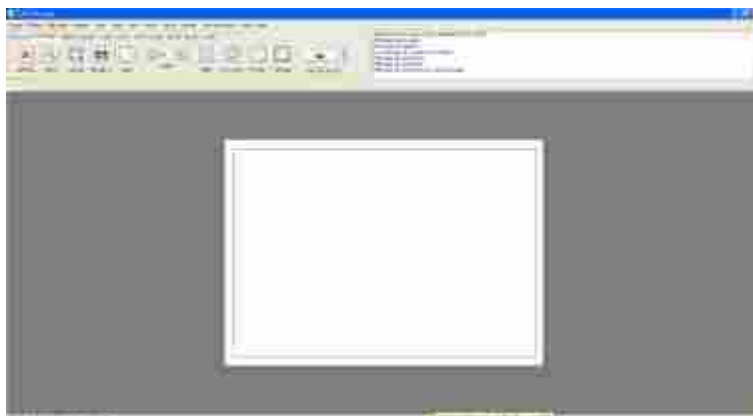




#### 4.9 How to display the document in landscape?

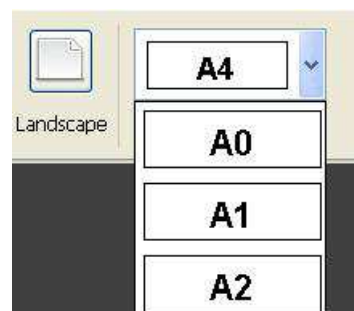


There are two ways to display the document in landscape or use the command **Landscape** of the **Display** toolbar, or use the **Display / Landscape** menu.

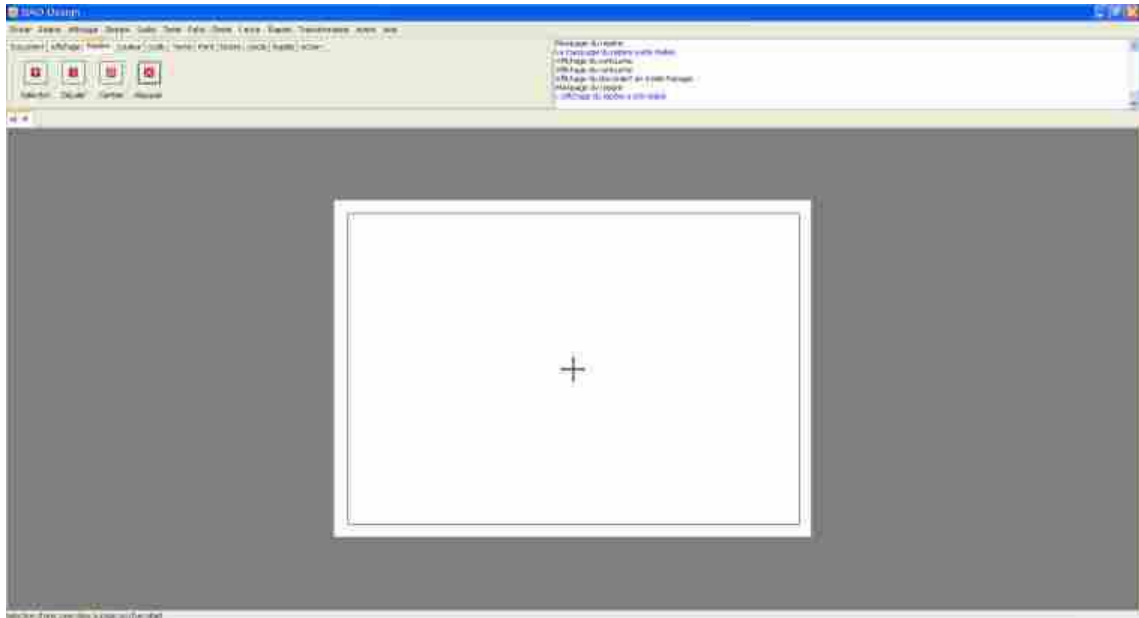
Just use the box for selecting the **Display** toolbar.



## 5 Management landmark

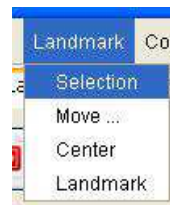
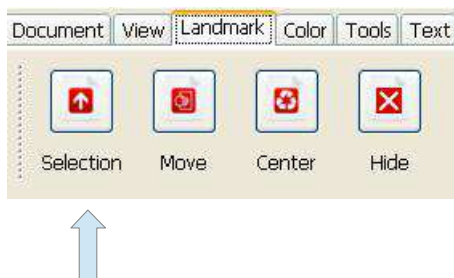
### 5.1 What is the function of the landmark?

The function of the landmark is to realize the position of the point (0, 0) on the page. The landmark can be selected to be moved. It can also be hidden.



### 5.2 How to select the landmark?

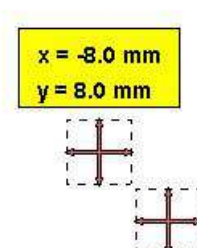
There are two ways to select the landmark, or use the command **Selection** of the **Landmark** toolbar or use the **Landmark / Selection** menu.

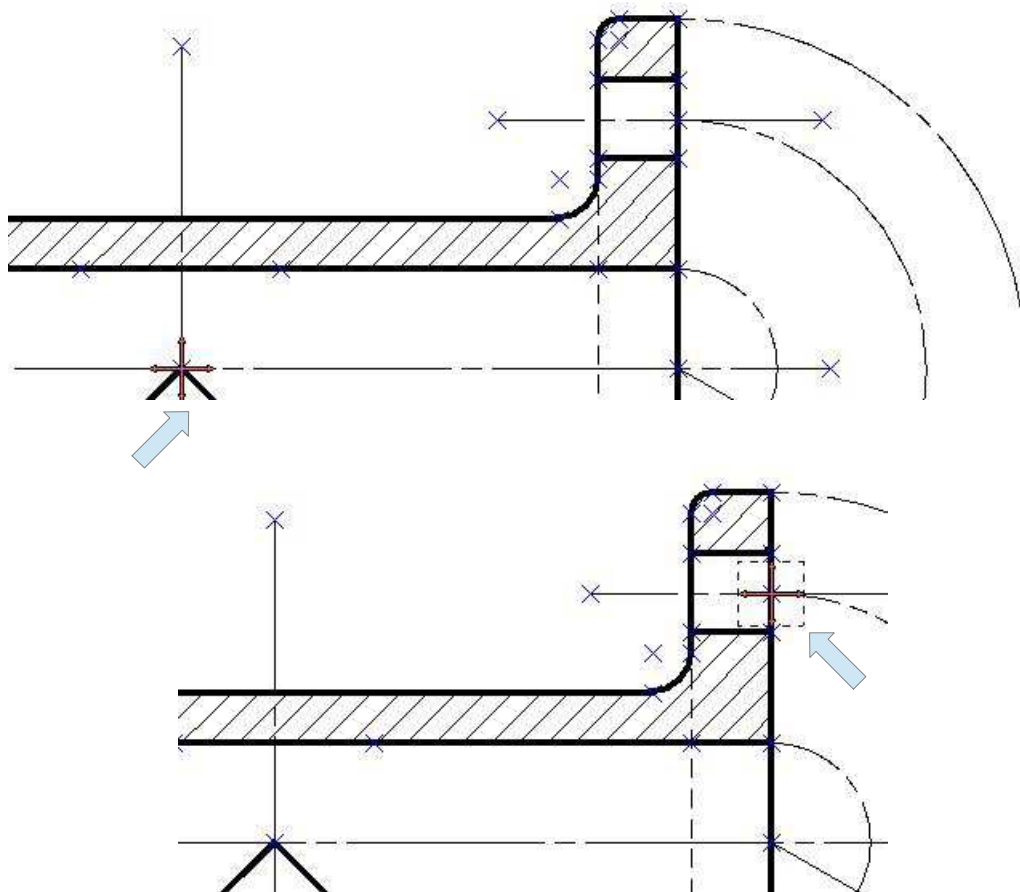


### 5.3 How to move the landmark?

To move the landmark, you must initially select it, then move it with the mouse.

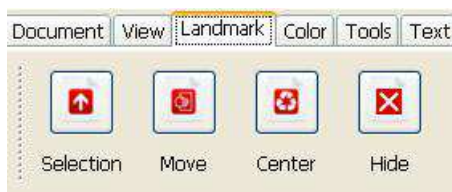
The landmark is attracted to different parts of the drawing. This allows to place precisely at the desired location.





#### 5.4 How to shift the landmark?

There are two ways to move the landmark, or use the command **Move** of the **landmark** tool bar, or use the **Landmark / Move** menu.

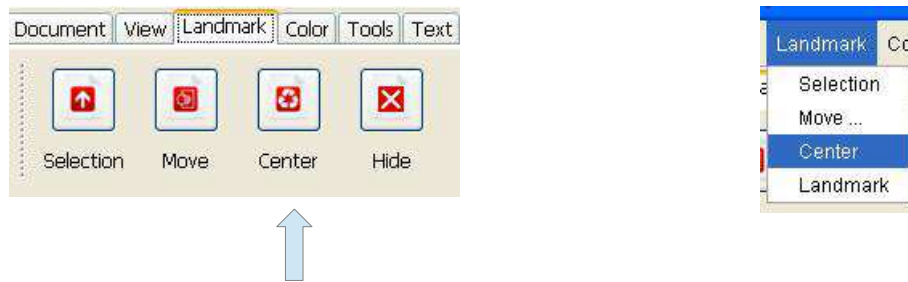


This gives access to a dialog box to enter the values of the desired movement.



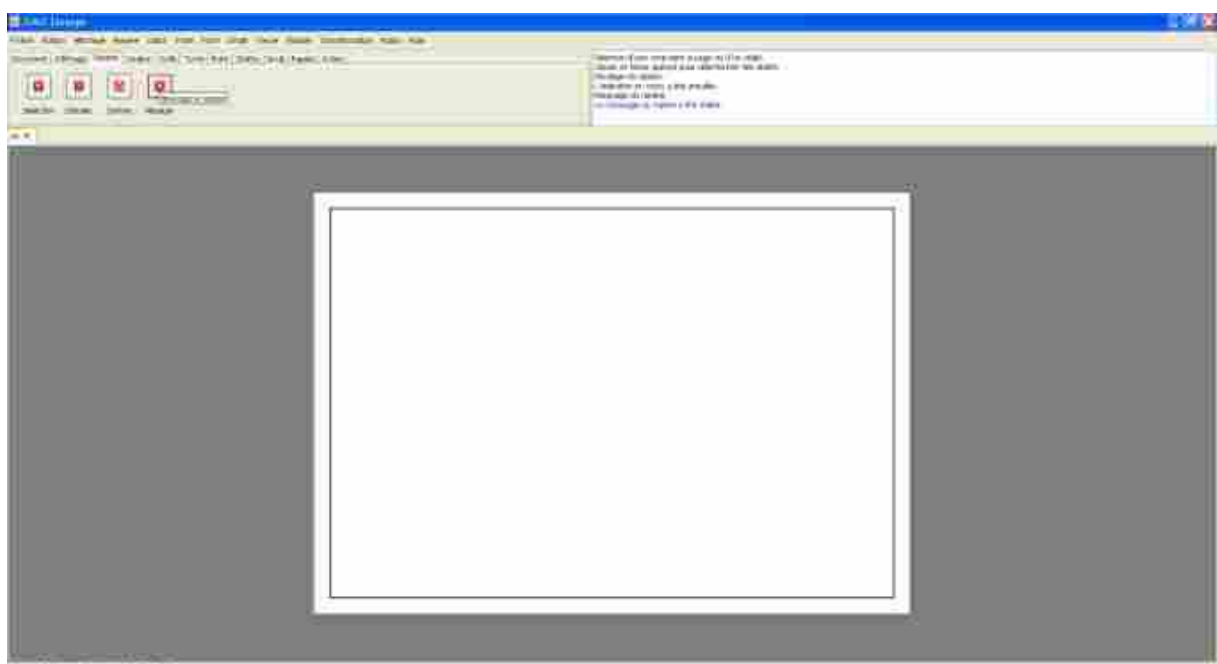
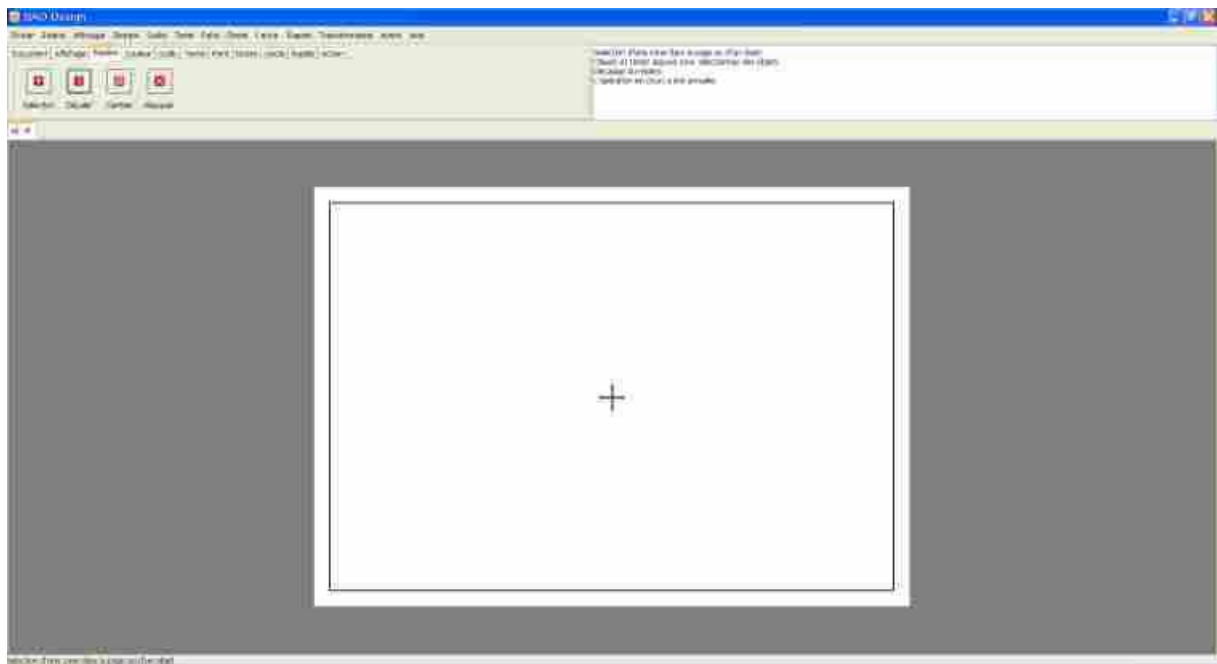
#### 5.5 How to center the marker ?

There are two ways to hide the marker or use the command **Hide** of the **Landmark** tool bar, or use the **Landmark / Hide** menu.

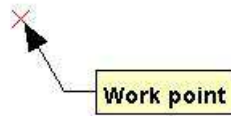


## 6 Particular points

### 6.1 What is a particular point?

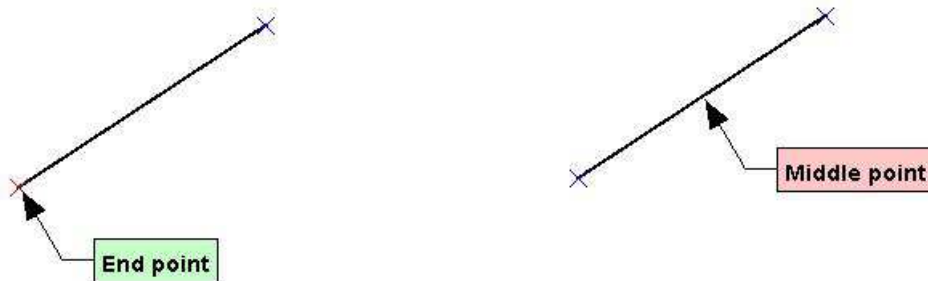
This is a point such as the midpoint of a segment.

A single point is a particular point, it will be called point construction.

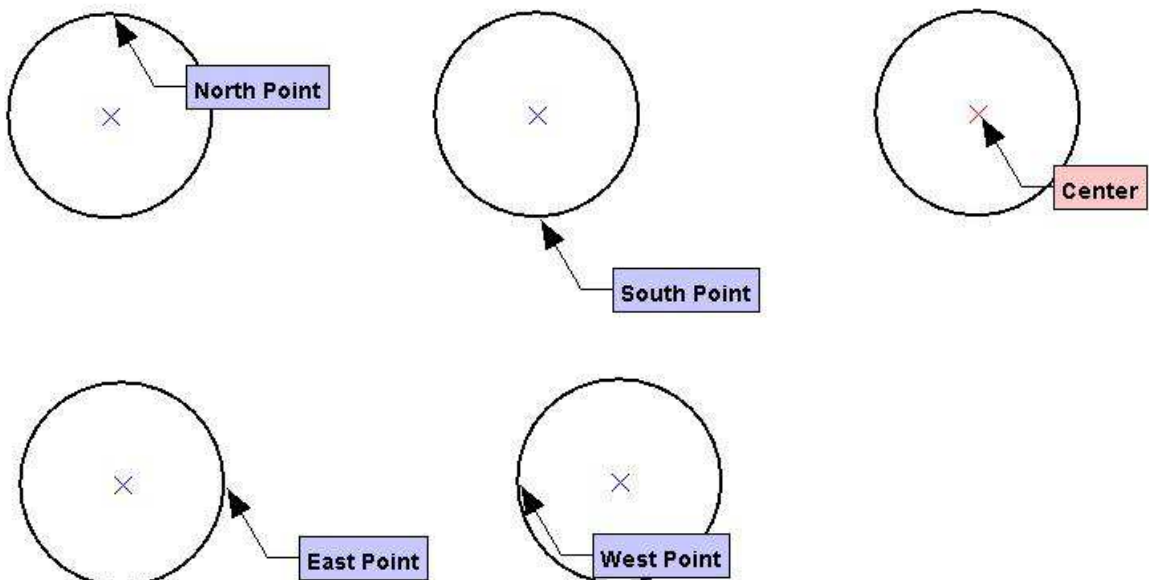


These points have the distinction of being magnetized. Their presence greatly facilitates and accelerates the efficiency of the user.

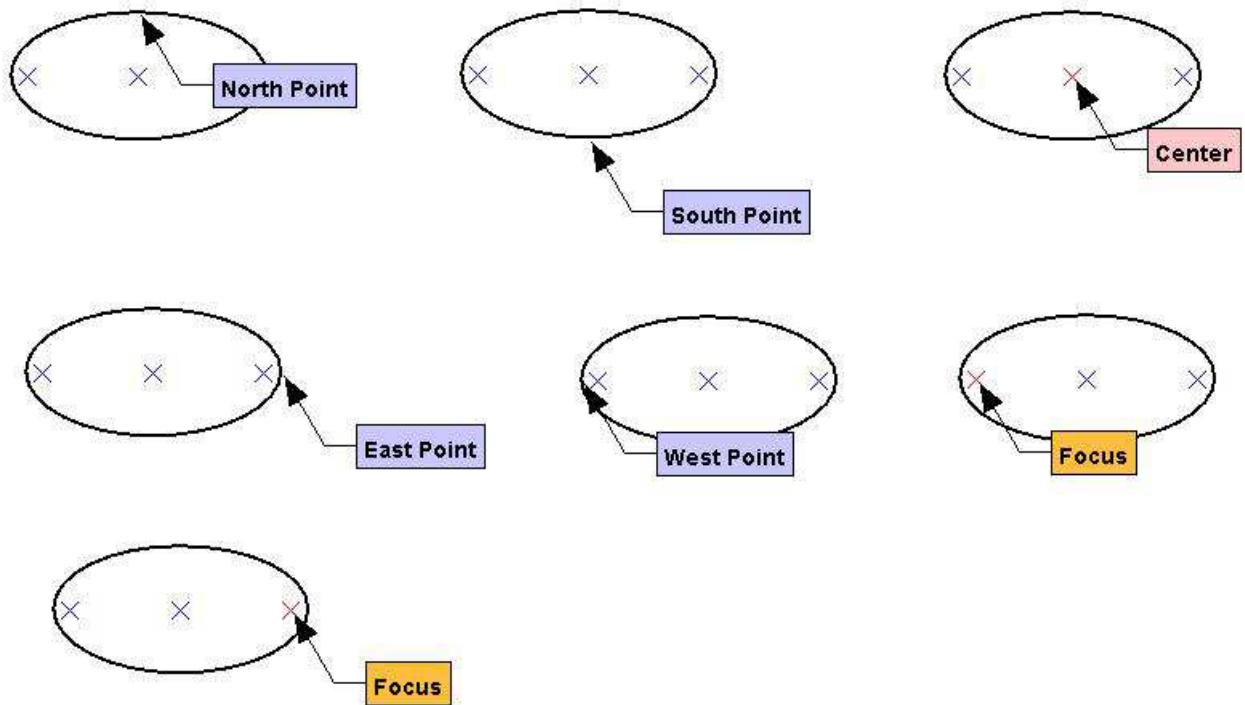

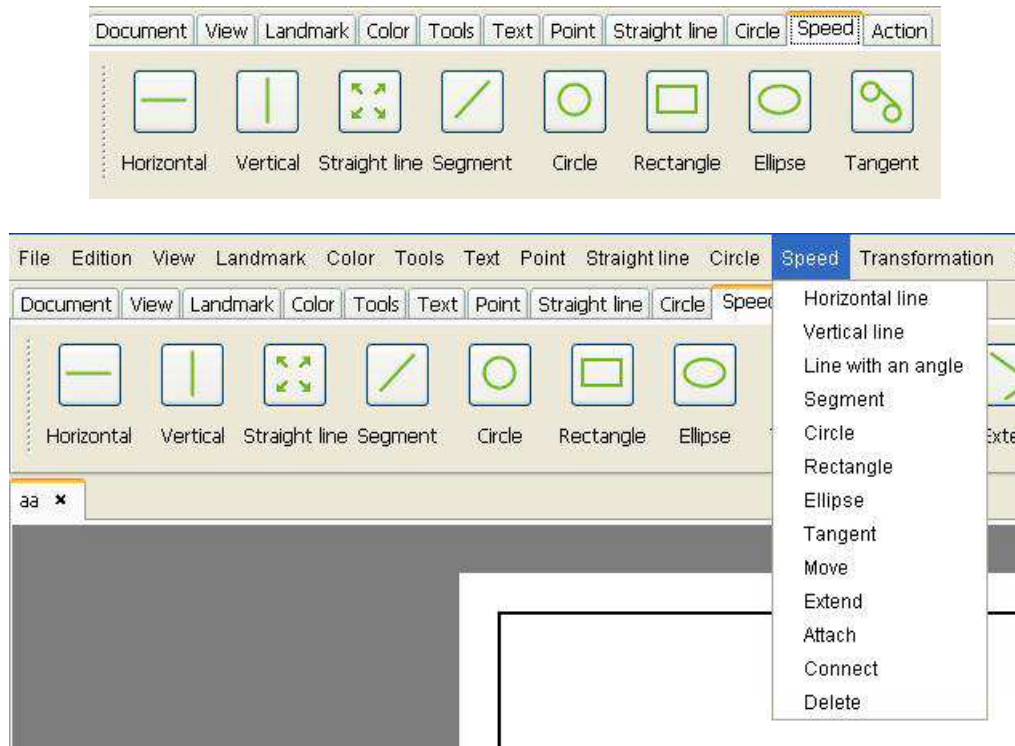




## 7 My first drawing elements

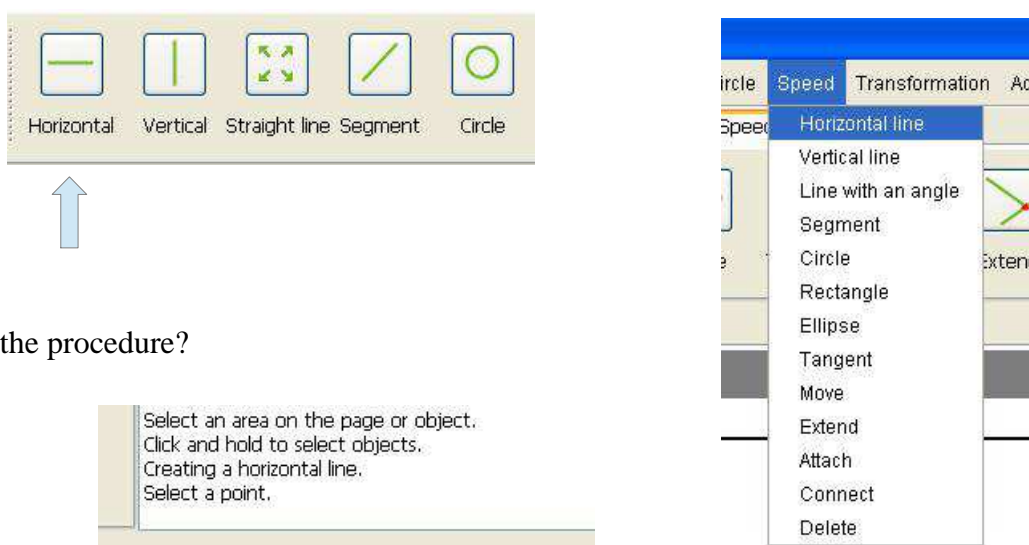
### 7.1 What fast objects?

Fast objects are functions to draw faster design elements. These functions are available in the **Speed** Tools bar or the **Speed** menu.



### 7.2 How to draw a horizontal line?

There are two ways to draw a horizontal line in a document, or use the command **Horizontal** of the **speed** tool bar, or use the **Speed / Horizontal line** menu.

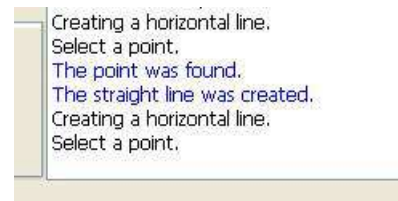


What is the procedure?

Select a point:

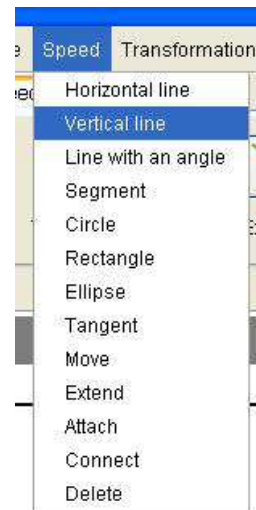
To select a point, just click with the mouse (left click) where is the point in the document. If you click in a place where there is no point, the point will be created.



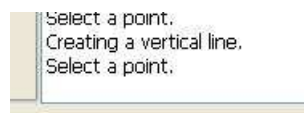


### 7.3 How to draw a vertical line?

There are two ways to draw a vertical line in a document, or use the command **Vertical** of the **Speed** tool bar or use **Speed / Vertical line** menu.

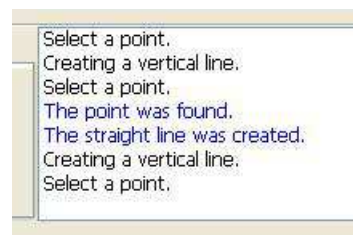

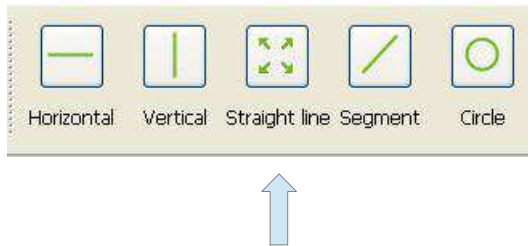

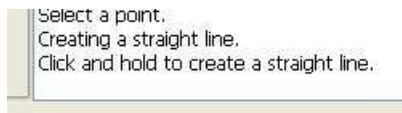


### 7.4 How to draw a line at an angle to the nearest degree?

There are two ways to draw a line with an angle in a document, or use the command **Line** of the **Speed** tool bar, or use the **Speed / Line with an angle** menu.

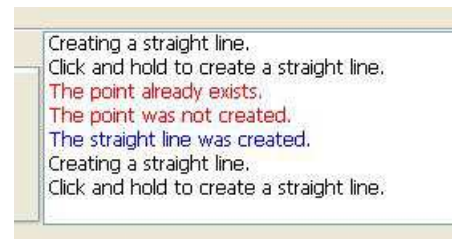
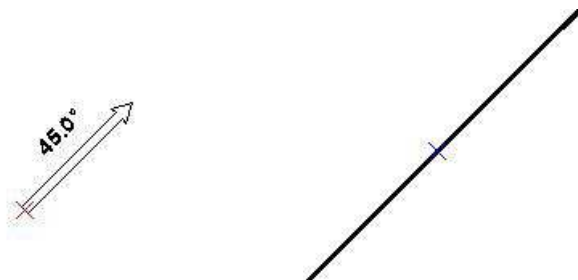

There are two ways to draw a segment in a document, or use the command **Segment** the **Speed** tool bar, or use the **Speed / Segment** menu.

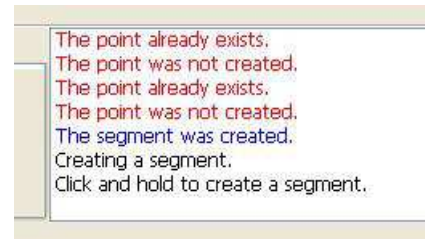
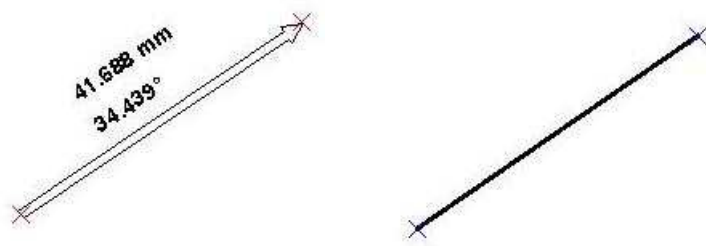

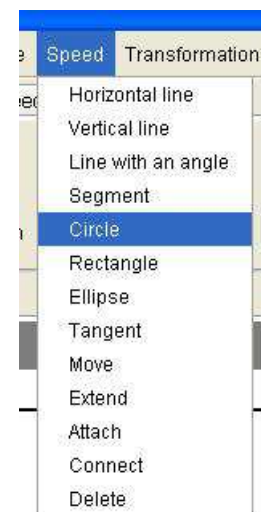
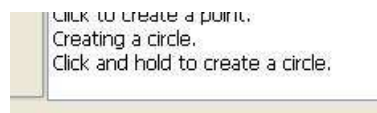


## 7.6 How to draw a circle whose radius is accurate to the millimeter?

There are two ways to draw a circle within a millimeter in a document, or use the command **Circle** of the **Speed** tool bar or use **Speed / Circle** menu.

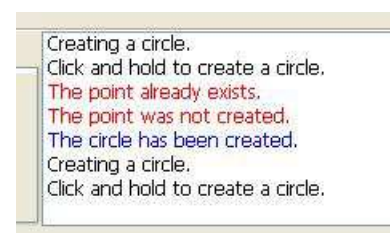
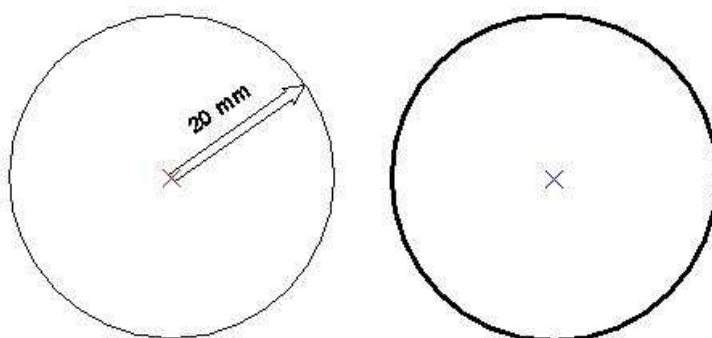

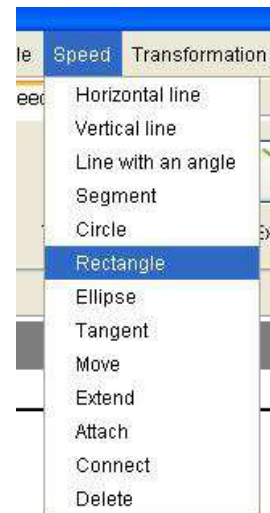
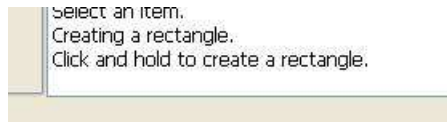


## 7.7 How to draw a rectangle?

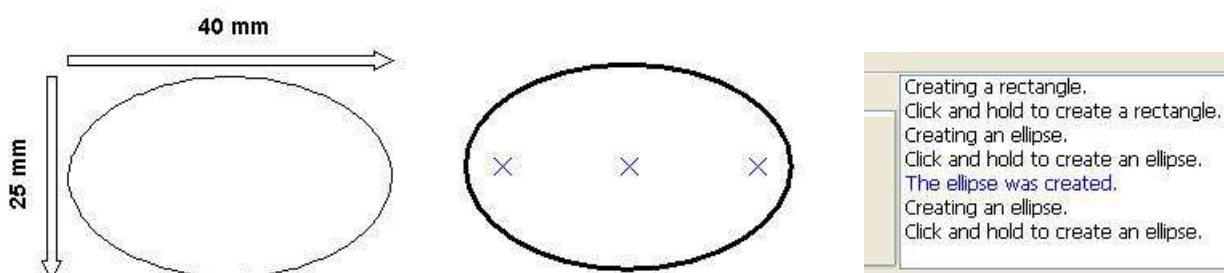
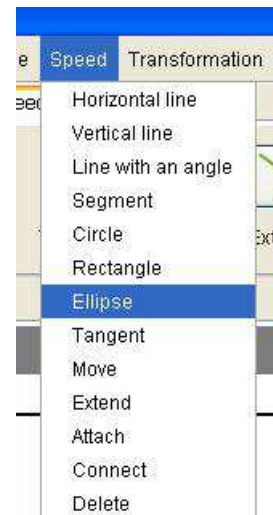
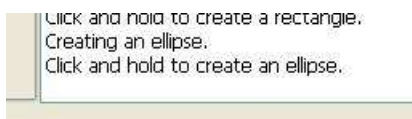


## 7.8 How to draw an ellipse?

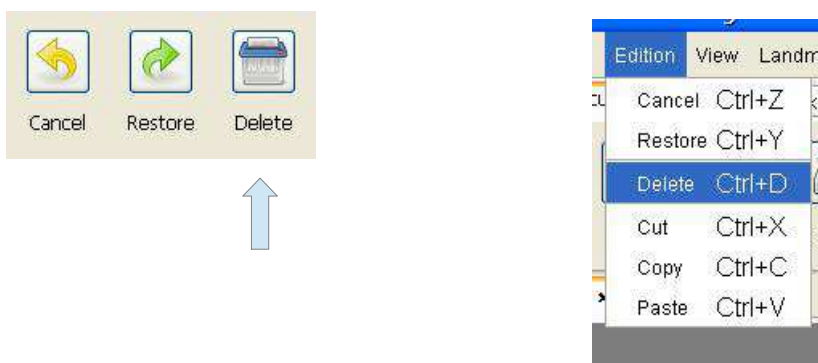
## 7.9 How to delete a drawing item?

### 7.9.1 The classic delete

The classic delete removes a drawing item in its entirety. It may be the following items:

- A line
- A half-line
- A segment
- An arc
- An ellipse arc
- A circle
- An ellipse
- A point

To use the classic delete, use the command **Delete** from the **Edit** tool bar or the **Edit / Delete** menu.

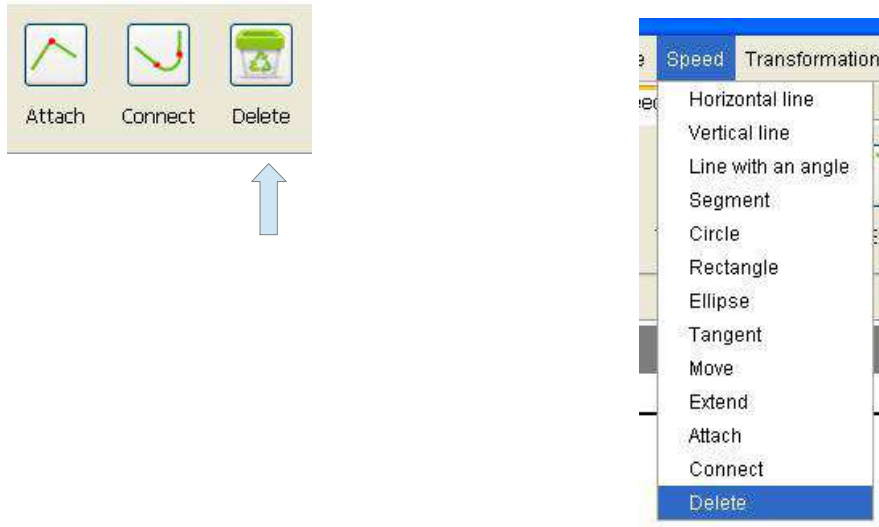


Here is an example of removing a circle. In this case the circle is removed entirely.

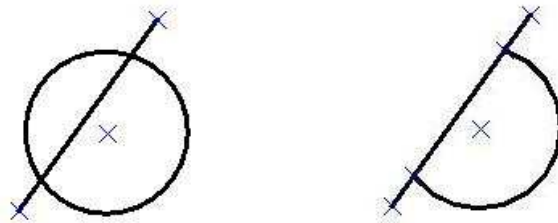


### 7.9.2 The quick delete

The quick delete removes a portion of an element. This function does not remove a point. To use the quick delete, use the command **Delete** from the **Speed** toolbar or **Speed / Delete** menu.



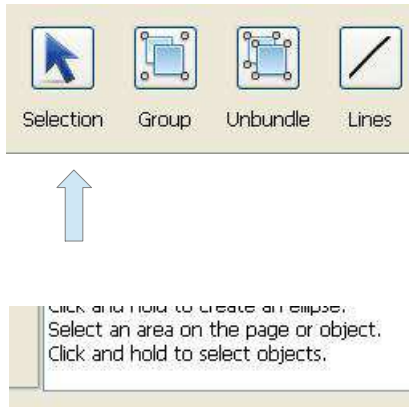
Here the example of delete of a portion of a circle.



## 8 Selection

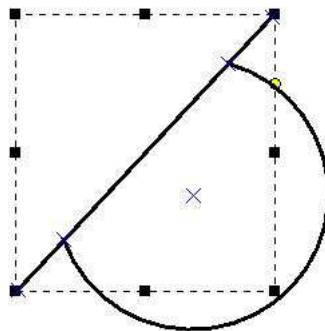
### 8.1 How to select an item?

There are two ways to select an object in a document, or use the command **Select** from the **Tools** toolbar, or use the **Tools / Selection** menu.



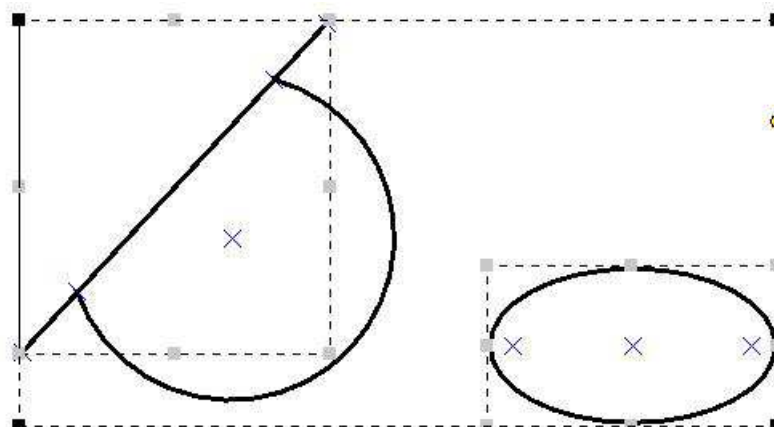
#### 8.1.1 How to select a single object?

To do this, simply click on the object you want to select.



#### 8.1.2 How to select multiple objects individually?

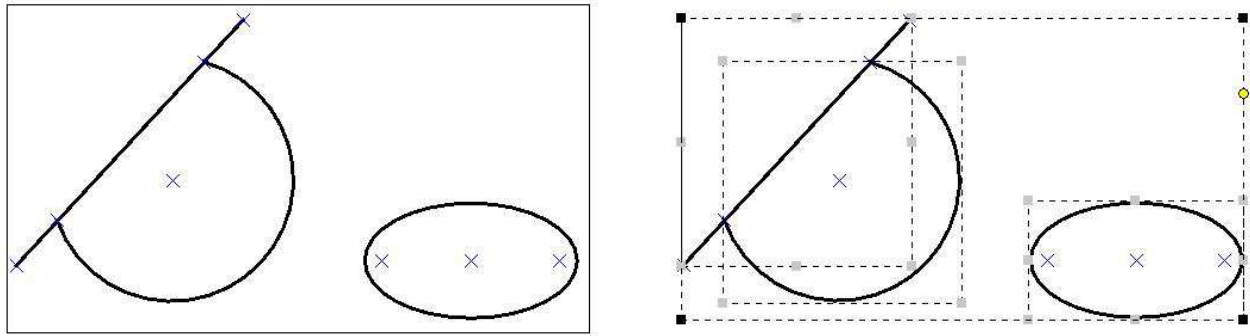
To do this, simply click on each of the objects you want to select by holding the CTRL key.





### 8.1.3 How to select a group of objects?

You just have to supervise all the objects you want to select with the selection rectangle with the mouse.



### 8.1.4 How to deselect?

To do this just click outside the selection area.

## 8.2 What are the possibilities of the selection tool?

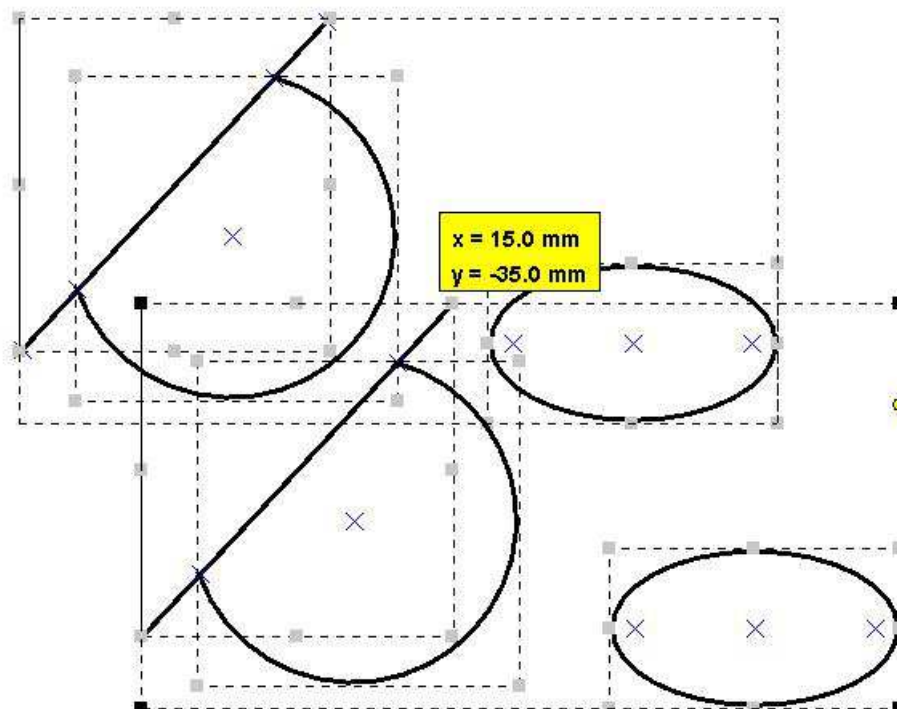
Once a set of objects selected, it is possible to perform a number of operations directly on that selection.

These are the following operations:

- Translation
- Rotation
- Scaling
- Delete

### 8.2.1 How to do a translation to the millimeter?

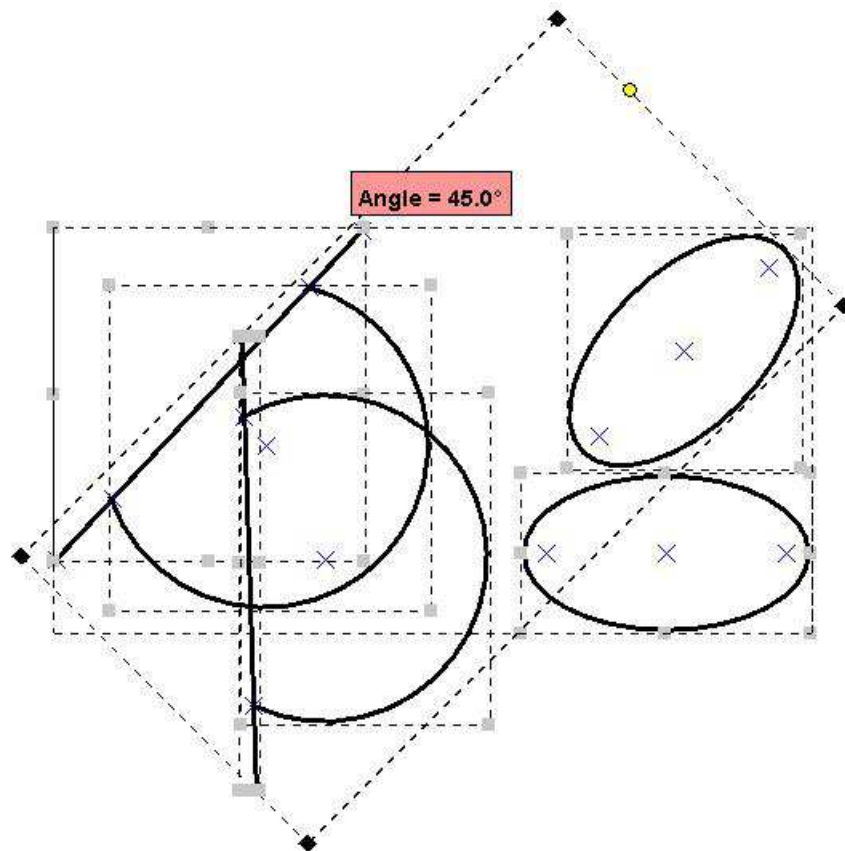
To do this, simply click on the selection and move the mouse horizontally and vertically according to the information provided by the viewing box information.





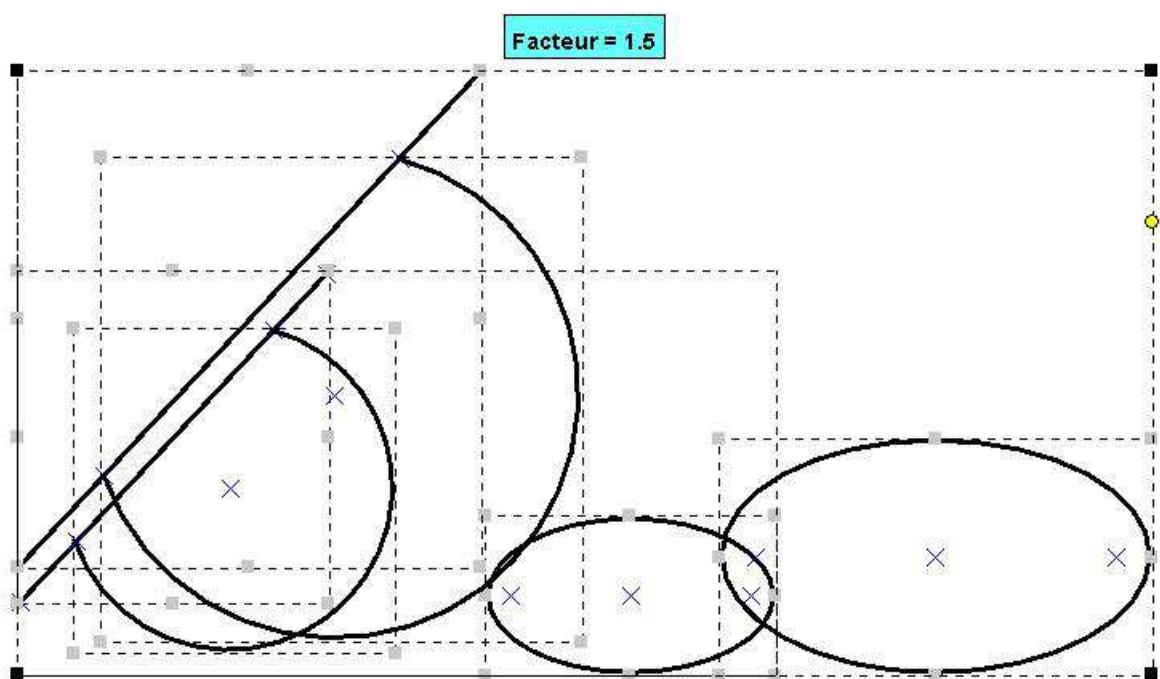
### 8.2.2 How to rotate?

To do this, simply click on the yellow circle to the selection and move the mouse horizontally and vertically according to the information provided by the viewing box information.



### 8.2.3 How to scaling?

To do this, simply click on one of the black handles the selection and move the mouse horizontally and vertically according to the information provided by the viewing box information.

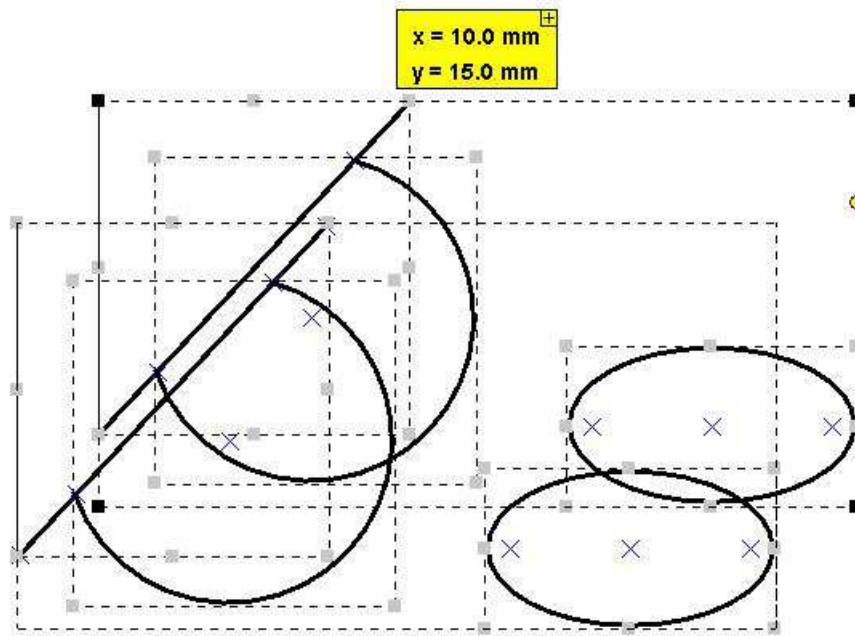


### 8.2.4 How to delete?

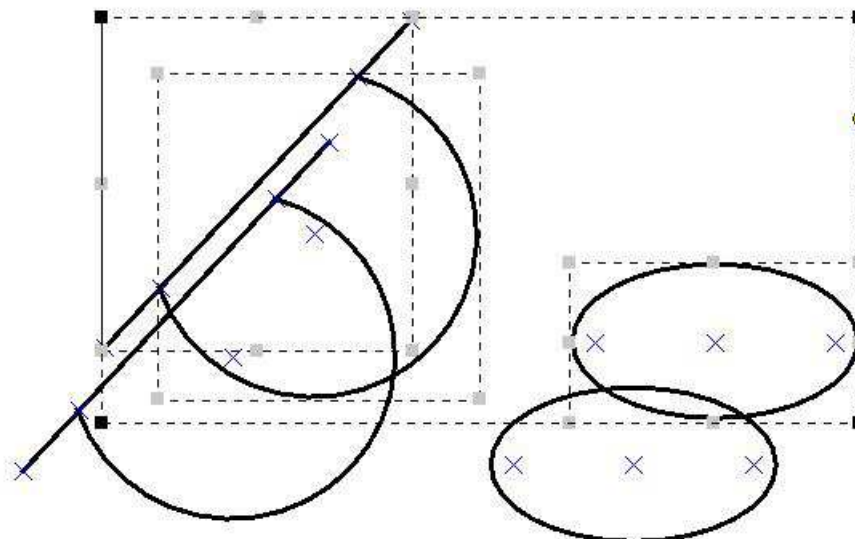
To delete the selected objects, simply press the Delete key.

### 8.2.5 Why use the CTRL key?

In a translation, a rotation, or scaling, pressing the CTRL key to do a duplicate. A small plus sign appears in the viewing box information.



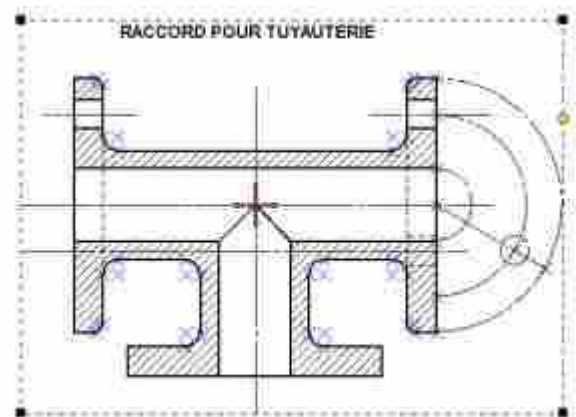
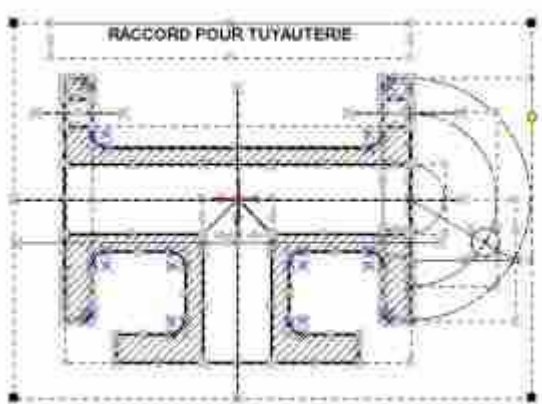
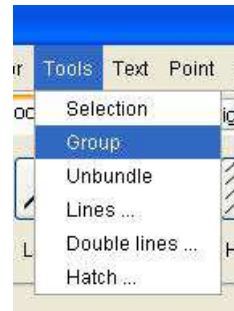

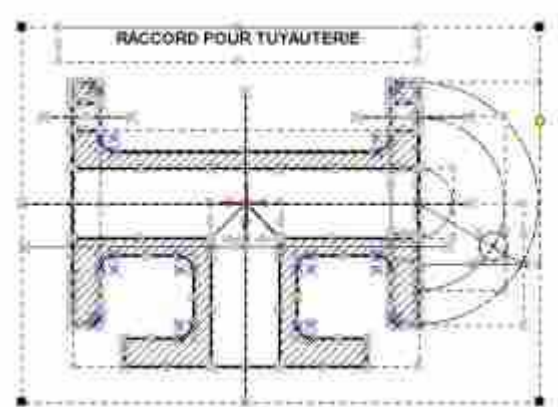
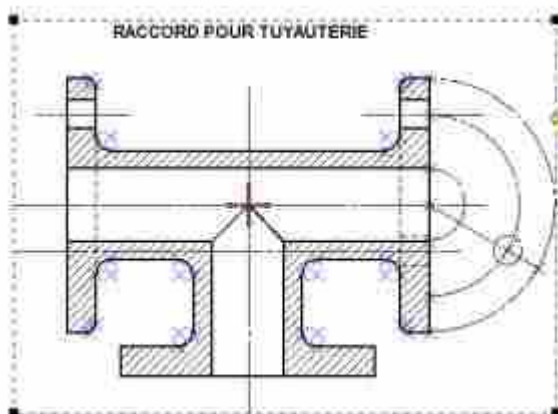
### 8.3.1 How to group selected objects?

There are two ways to group objects in a document, or use the command **Group** from the **Tools** toolbar, or use the **Tools / Group** menu.



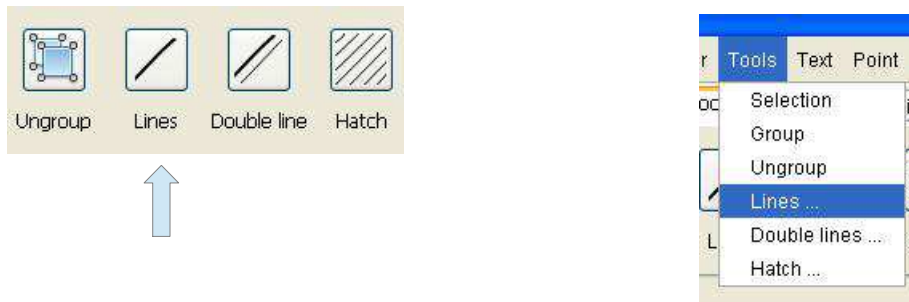
### 8.3.2 How to ungroup objects selected?

There are two ways to ungroup objects in a document, or use the command **Ungroup** from the **Tools** toolbar, or use the **Tools / Ungroup** menu.

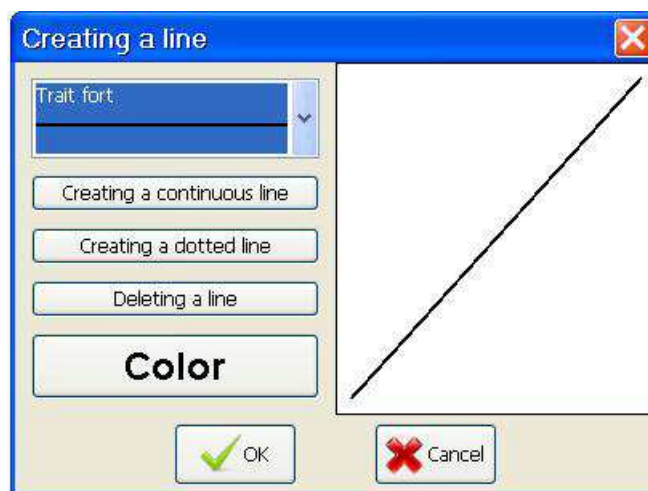


## 9 Lines

There are two options for accessing the creation of a line type or use the command **Line** from the **Tools** toolbar, or use the **Tools / Line** menu.



This command will open a dialog box for creating a new type of line.



The dialog box is divided into two parts, one on the left giving access to a number of actions, and some right to view the selected line.

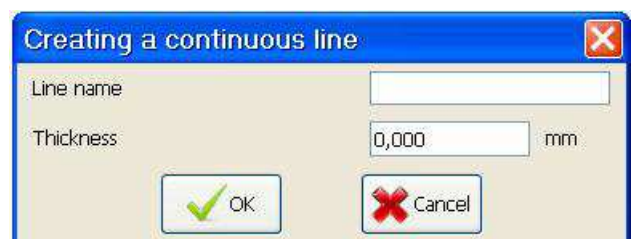
- **The choice box:** It lets you choose the type of line that you want to view or delete. Exists in a number of software pre-defined features. These types of terms are not removable, only line types created by user are deletable by it.
- **The creation of a continuous line button:** This button opens a dialog box for creating a continuous line type.
- **The creation of a dotted line button:** This button opens a dialog box for creating a dotted line type.
- **The Delete button on a line:** This button allows you to delete a line type created by the user. The types of features provided by default by the software are not deletable.

### 9.1 How to create a continuous line?

It should firstly press the Create button in a continuous line of Creation dialog box. This will open a dialog box for entering the information needed to create the type of baseline.

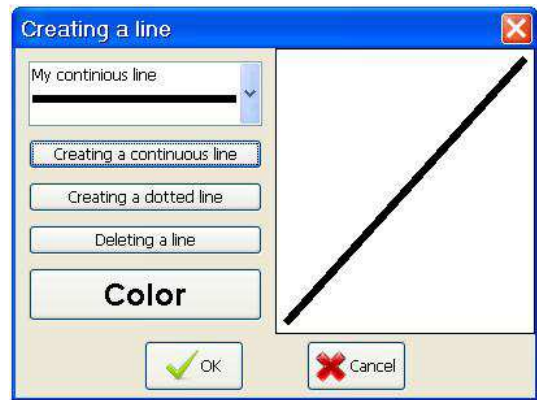
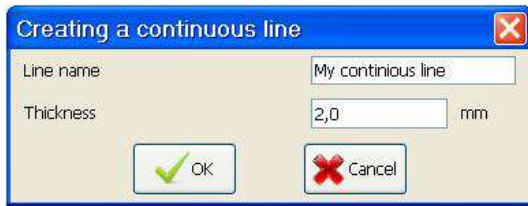
This dialog has two fields:

- **The name line field:** This field is required and inform to the name of the line type.
- **The thickness field:** This field can not be zero. It defines the line thickness in millimeters.

## 9.2 How to create a dotted line?

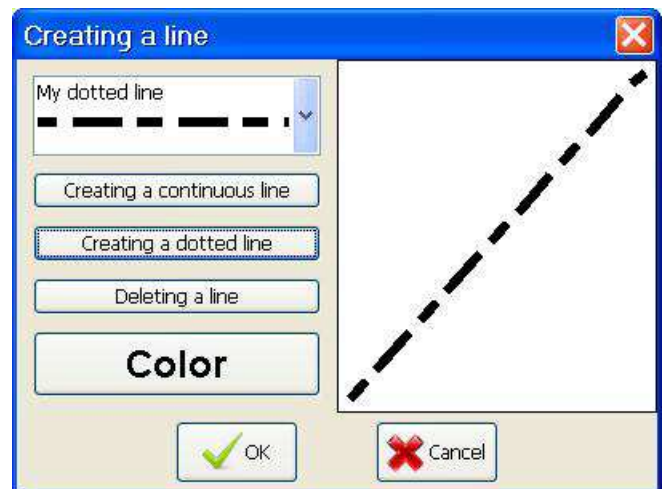
It should firstly press the Create button a dotted line of Creation dialog box. This will open a dialog box for entering the information needed to create the type of dotted line.

This dialog has five fields:

- **The name line field:** This field is required and inform to the name of the line type.
- **The thickness field:** This field can not be zero. It defines the line thickness in millimeters.
- **The Line 1 field:** This field can not be zero. It defines the length of the first dash millimeter.
- **The space field:** This field can not be zero. It defines the length of the space between the two dashes in millimeters.
- **The Line 2 field:** This field can not be zero. It defines the length of the second dash millimeter.

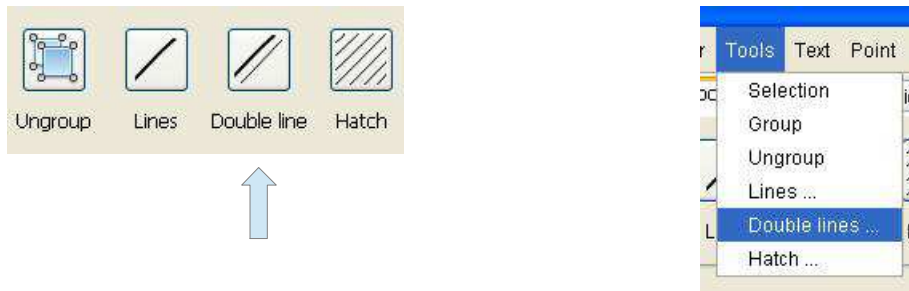


Example dotted line.



### 9.3 How to create a double line?

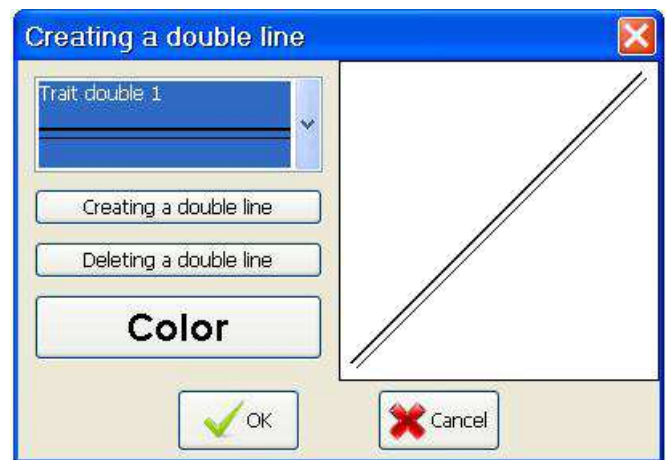
There are two options for accessing the creation of a type of double line, or use the command **Double line** the **Tools** toolbar, or use the **Tools / Double Line** menu.



This command will open a dialog box for creating a new type of double line.

The dialog box is divided into two parts, one on the left giving access to a number of actions, and some right to view the selected line.

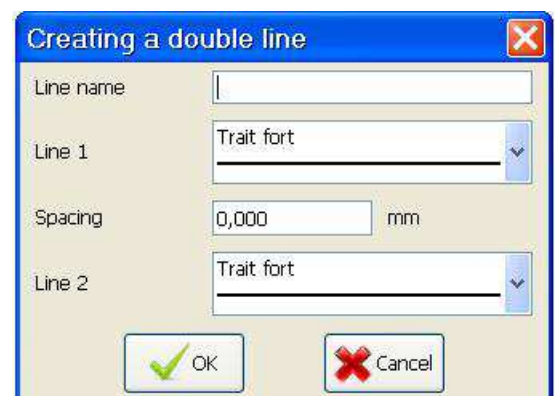
- **The choice box:** It lets you choose the type of double line that you want to view or delete. Exists in a number of software features dual predefined. These types of double lines are not removable, only two types of feature set by the user are deletable by it.
- **The button Creating a double line:** This button opens a dialog box for creating a kind of double line.
- **The button Deleting a double line:** This button allows you to delete a type of double line created by the user. The types of double line provided by default by the software are not deletable.



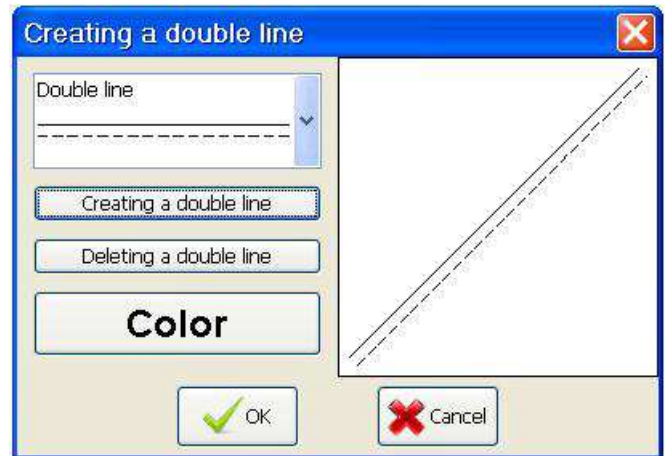
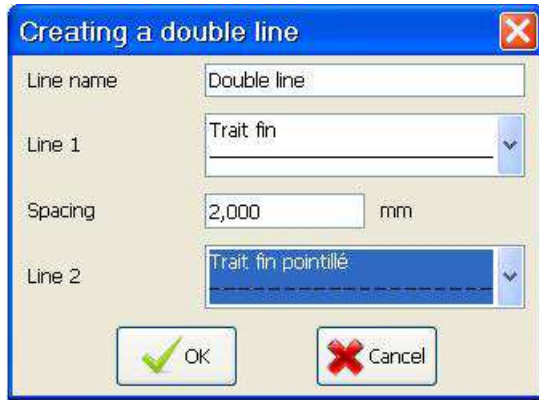
To create a type of double line, you must initially press the Create button with a double line of the dialog box Creating a double line. This will open a dialog box for entering the information needed to create the type of double line.

This dialog box has four fields:

- **The Name line field:** This field is required and information on the type name double line.
- **The Trait 1 Field:** It defines the type of line the first line. It can be a solid line or a dotted line.
- **The Spacing field:** This field can not be zero. It defines the distance in millimeters between the two types of line.
- **The Trait 2 Field:** It defines the type of line the second line. It can be a solid line or a dotted line.



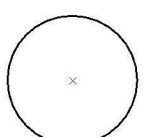
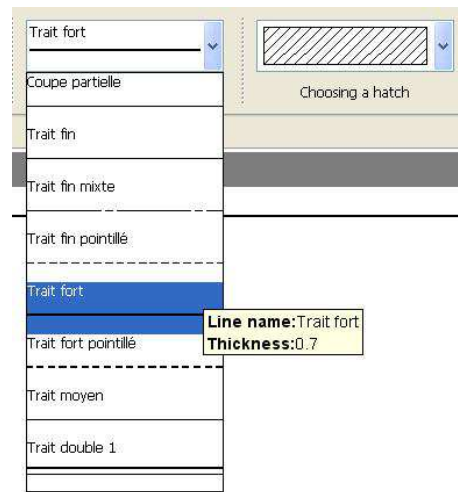
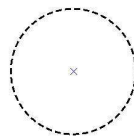
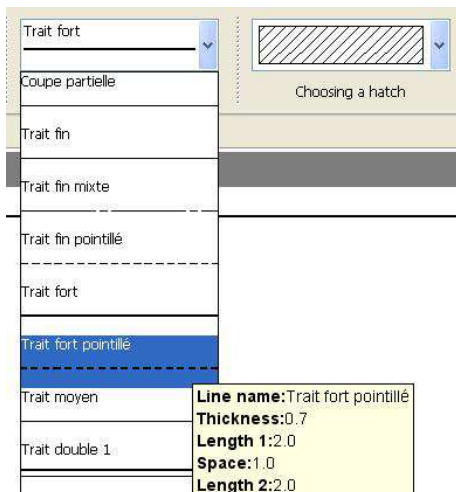

## 9.4 How to select a line type?

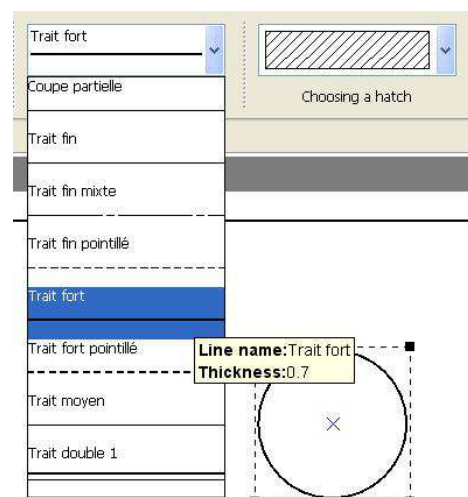
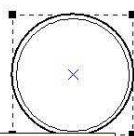
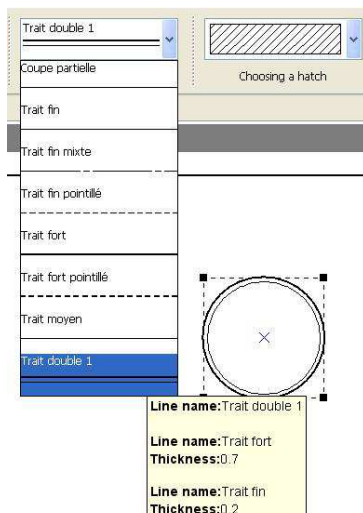
To select a particular type of feature, simply select the type of line in the list of choices **Choosing a line** in the **Tools** tab.

The tool tip gives all the necessary information on the selected line type.



## 9.5 How to change the line style of a design element?

To change the line style of an element of design, it is first necessary to select the design element, then select the new type of line in the list of choices **Choosing a line** of the **Tools** tab.



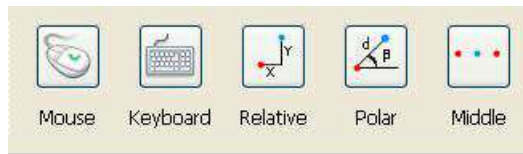


## 10 Points

### 10.1 How to plot a point with the mouse?

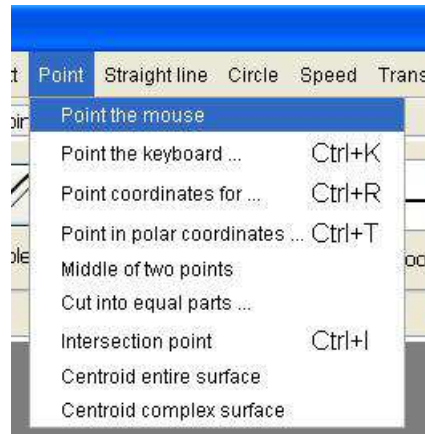
This feature is useful when you have activated the grid.

There are two ways to create a point with the mouse, or use the command **Mouse** of the **Point** toolbar, or use the **Point / Mouse** menu.



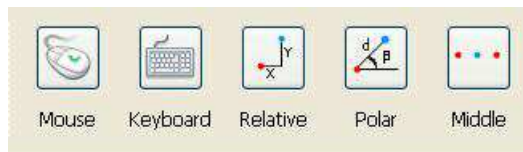

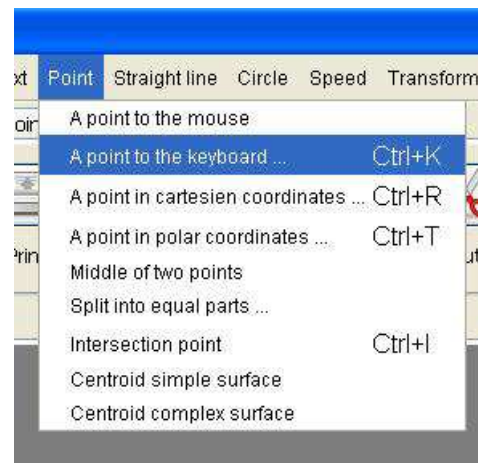
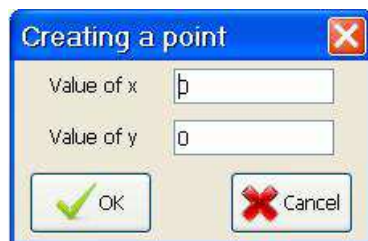


### 10.2 How to plot a point on the keyboard?

There are two ways to create a point on the keyboard or use the command **keyboard** of the **Point** toolbar, or use the **Point / Keyboard** menu.



This command will open a dialog box to create the point.



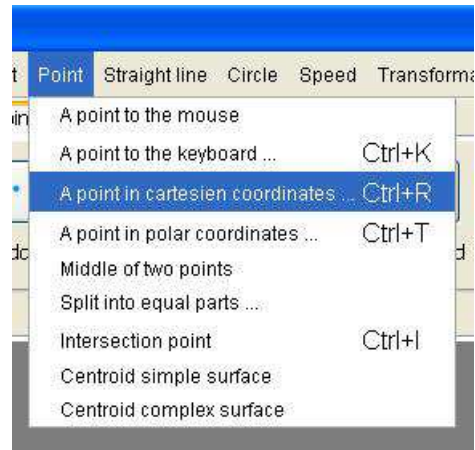
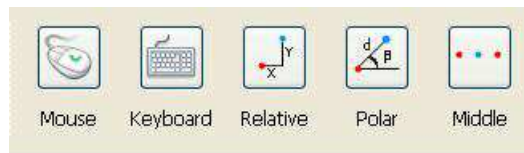
This dialog box consists of two fields:

- **The field Value of x:** This is the abscissa of the point.
- **The field Value of y:** This is the ordinate of the point.

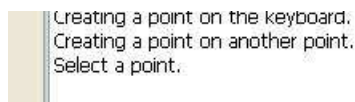
The point (0,0) is the center of a document.

### 10.3 How to plot a point in cartesian coordinates?

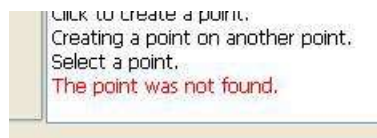
There are two ways to create a point relative to another point, or use the command **Relative** of the **Point** toolbar, or use the **Point / A point in cartesian coordinates** menu.



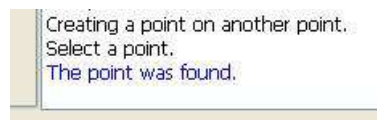
What is the procedure?



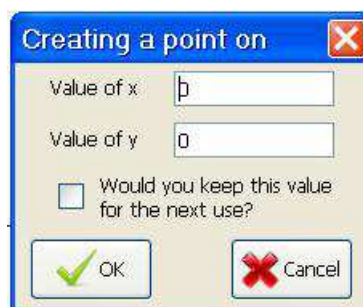
To select a point, just click with the mouse (left click) where is the point in the document. If you click in a place where there is no point, a message will indicate that the point was not found.



Otherwise a message will indicate that the point has been found.

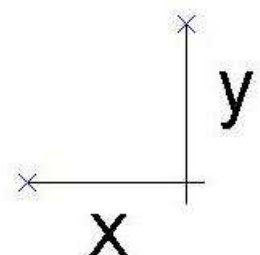


This command will open a dialog box to create the point.



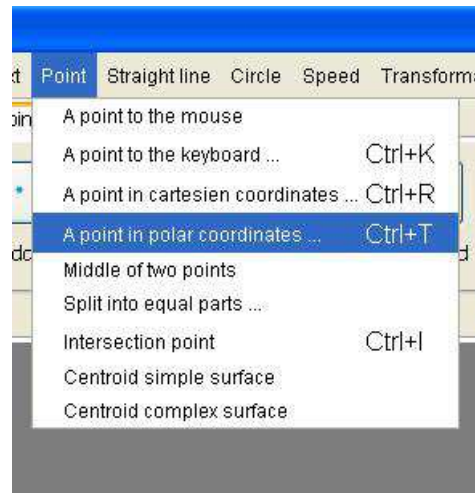
This dialog box consists of two fields:

- **The field Value of x:** This is the relative abscissa of the point.
- **The field Value of y:** This is the relative ordinate of the point.

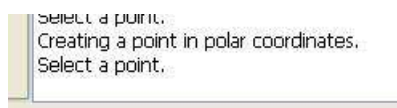


## 10.4 How to plot a point in polar coordinates?

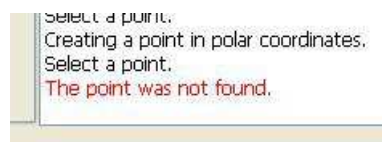
There are two ways to create a point in polar coordinates, or use the command **Polar** in **Point** toolbar, or use the **Point / A point in polar coordinates** menu.



What is the procedure?



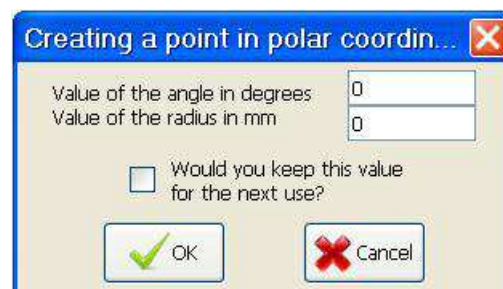
To select a point, just click with the mouse (left click) where is the point in the document. If you click in a place where there is no point, a message will indicate that the point was not found.



Otherwise a message will indicate that the point has been found.

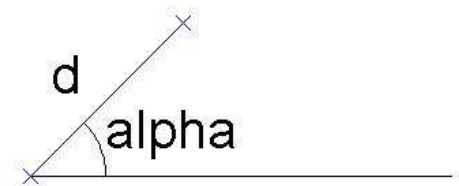


This command will open a dialog box to create the point.



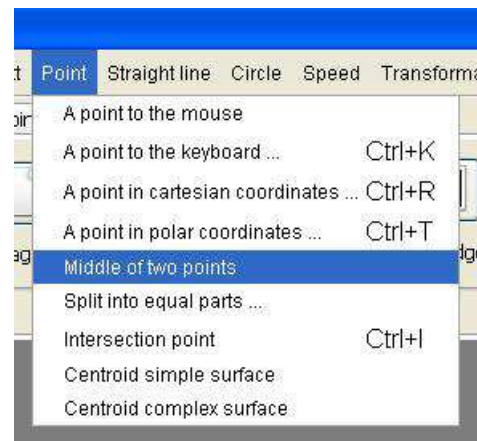
This dialog box consists of two fields:

- **The field Value of the angle in degrees:** This is the angle that the line through the two points with the horizontal.
- **The field Value of the radius in millimeters:** This is the distance between the two points.

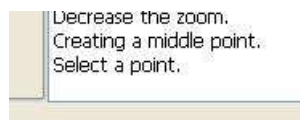


## 10.5 How to draw a middle of two points?

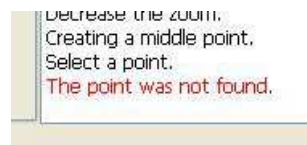
There are two ways to create a midpoint of two points, use the command **Middle** in the **Point** toolbar, or use the **Point / Middle two points** menu.



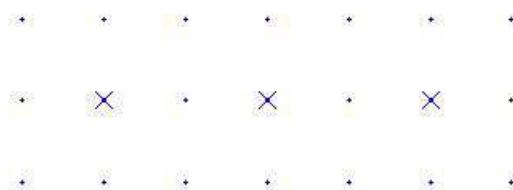
What is the procedure?



To select a point, just click with the mouse (left click) where is the point in the document. If you click in a place where there is no point, a message will indicate that the point was not found.

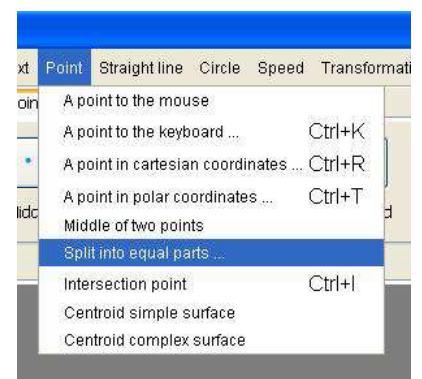


To select a second point, just click with the mouse (left click) where is the point in the document. If you click in a place where there is no point, a message will indicate that the point was not found.

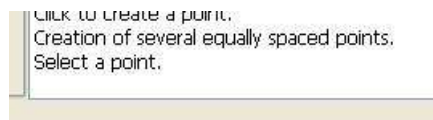


## 10.6 How to draw several equidistant from each other points?

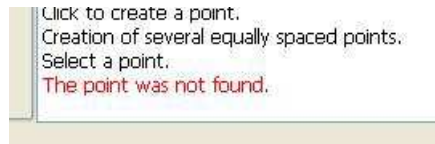
There are two ways to create equidistant from each other points, use the command **Cut** from the **Point** toolbar or use the menu **Point / Cut into equal parts**.



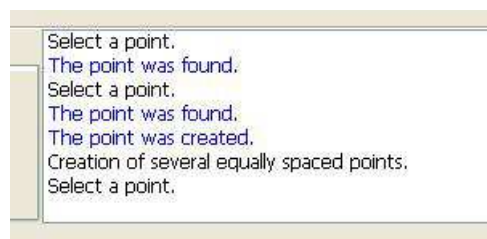

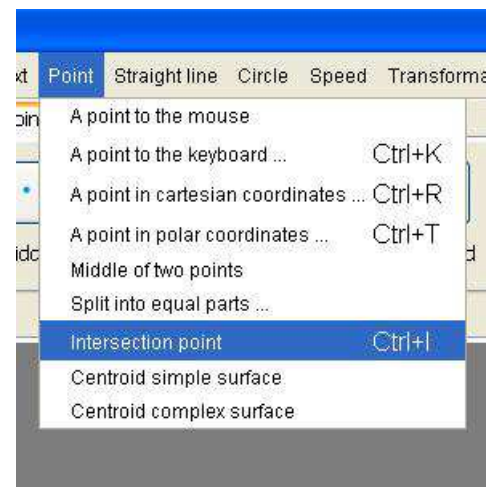
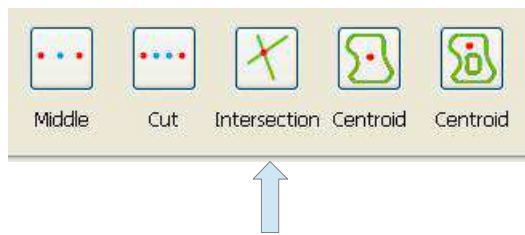
- The field Number of parts: This is the number of equal parts into which the distance is cut between the two points.



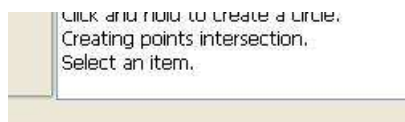


## 10.7 How to draw an intersection point?

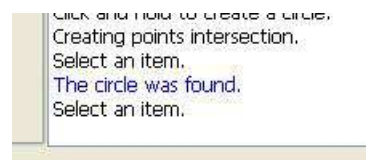
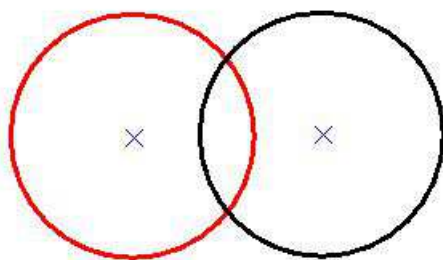

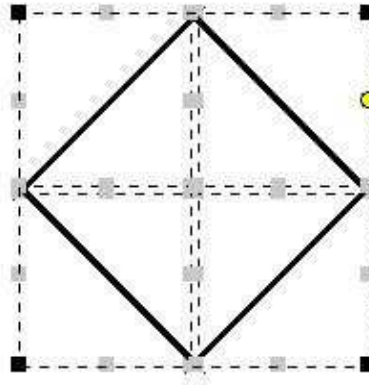


## 13 Transformations
